

Candlemas Day is on February 2^{nd} . It is another name for the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Forty days after His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple for the rites of purification and dedication. On



Candlemas, many Christians receive blessed candles that are used for the rest of the year in their homes and serve as a symbol of Jesus Christ, who referred to Himself as the Light of the World. Candlemas Day was also important in the lives of farmers. An old English song went as follows: "If Candlemas be fair and bright, / Come, Winter, have another flight. / If Candlemas brings clouds and rain, / Go, Winter, and come not again." So, if the bright sun "overshadows" the brightness of Candlemas Day, there will be more winter. However, if the light of Candlemas Day radiates through the gloom and darkness of the day, the end of winter is near. We celebrate the feast day of St. Blaise on February 3rd. St. Blaise was a physician before becoming a bishop. Tradition holds that he was to have miraculously cured a child who nearly died because of a fishbone caught in the throat. St. Blaise is often invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illness of the throat. Because of this, it is tradition to



offer the Rite of Blessings of Throats. Traditionally using two crossed and unlighted candles, the priest (or other minister) touches the throat of each person, saying: Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop, and martyr, may God deliver you from all ailments of the throat and from every other evil: + in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holv Spirit. Amen. Throats will be blessed at the Saturday, February 4th and Sunday, February 5th Masses.
