



Sacred Heart Christian Mothers Meeting: Tuesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> (after 7:00PM Mass)

The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord is one of the earliest Christian festivals. Jesus met several times with his disciples during the 40 days after His resurrection to instruct them on how to carry out His teachings. On the 40<sup>th</sup> day He took them to the Mount of Olives,



where they watched as He ascended to heaven. Ascension is officially celebrated on the 40<sup>th</sup> day of Easter. It occurs ten days before Pentecost and always falls on a Thursday. However, in many dioceses of the United States, it is celebrated on the following Sunday.

Overall, the onsite team was very pleased with our school, and commended us on meeting and exceeding many of the MNSAA standards.

- The team recommends that assessment results be shared with all stakeholders, not just staff and families, and that the results be used to more effectively guide curriculum decisions.


