This week, I received a plain wooden cross with the inscription *He lives!* Thanks Brenda! Jesus is Alive indeed and the cross reminds us of everything He did for us. Jesus lives among us now, first and foremost, in the Eucharist, in every sacrament, in those who suffer and of course in our communities of faith. He lives in the Church He founded and the Kingdom He established will have no end.

I thank God for the good news of young people attending Church as they realize that this world doesn't provide the answers and the happiness our hearts look for. This movement is happening right now in the US, and we are also experiencing an increase in people joining the Catholic Church everywhere in our country. The Risen Christ is calling many people by name, and many are responding. Our mission is to provide the setting for God to encounter His people using our talents for service to the Church and through our prayers and welcoming attitude. The Church is growing in ways that are not visible to our eyes, and this is the time when we are supposed to be here, sharing our gifts that are needed for building God's Kingdom.

I thank God for our Bishop, priests, and deacons, and for all our committed parishioners. Let us keep each other in prayer and be builders of unity.

We all know that the Diocese of St Cloud, like many other dioceses in the US, is struggling to staff every parish with a priest so that the faithful can celebrate the Holy Eucharist and receive the Lord. We need more priests and they come from Catholic families like yours! Let us keep praying and promoting vocations to the priesthood and religious life! However, something needs to be done now as we don't have all the priests we need for the 131 parishes we have in the St. Cloud Diocese. We have less than 60 priests now, however, one will retire this July, another pastor is dealing with stage 4 cancer, and another pastor had a stroke a few weeks ago. Today, we make plans with a number in mind knowing that life happens

and that number may change suddenly. I remember what The Bishop said last year "I don't have any priest on the bench"

I'm glad to announce that at this time as I am typing this letter, I will continue as Pastor of our four churches and as far as I know, Fr Nathaniel will continue as the associate pastor. So far, this seems to be so. I'm thankful for the good priest that Fr Nathaniel is!

I plan to be on vacation for the months of May and June. I hope to go to Venezuela and visit my parents, since I haven't seen them since 2018. The bishop has given me this special permission to be gone for eight weeks, and I appreciate it. Fr Joe Korf, a retired priest, will be assisting Fr Nathaniel with all the Masses until I come back on June 30th. Please, show some Northern Cross hospitality to Fr Joe Korf and keep supporting Fr Nathaniel in his priestly ministry!

We are the Church of Christ, and we want to make His resurrection felt in every corner of our world. Our service and loving sacrifices will make that happen!

I pray that the Risen Lord may bless our faith communities, our families, our Church and School staff, and our youth and children (who are the future of the Church, as St John Paul II affirmed so many times). May the Risen Lord bless America and the whole world with the gift of Peace! Death no longer has the last word. Jesus conquered the grave and He will be with us until the end of the world!

I wish you a Happy Easter, filled with great faith, love and hope!
