Stewardship as a Way of Life

*"Do you not know that you are the temple of God,
and that the Spirit of God dwells within you?"*

1 Corinthians 3:16

Simply remembering that we are "temples of the Holy Spirit" should make our daily decision making relatively easy. If we truly want to imitate Jesus, then our words and actions should reflect the love, mercy, and forgiveness that flow from His Sacred Heart. Try it for one week.
