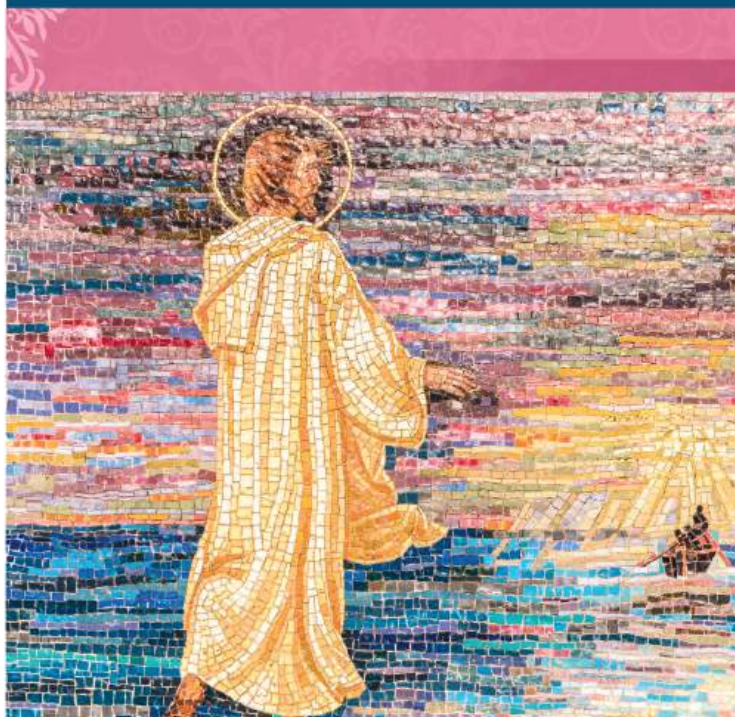

A NOTE FROM FATHER OMAR

Greetings:

If you are an active parishioner, you probably know that we are in the process of becoming one parish. Remember Parish refers to people in a specific territory, and Church refers to buildings. Our four parishes are to become one, since the Diocese does not have enough priests and the Law of the Church establishes a priest per parish ratio. At this point in time, we're still waiting for the Bishop to choose our new parish name and to give us the merger decree (i.e. the document that makes the new change official). The Bishop and his team have been overwhelmed with unexpected issues that have delayed the timeline they had planned at the beginning of the process. We want to be understanding and patient with the process. At this time, we are not contemplating closing any one of our four churches, BUT if the Diocese only has one priest for us in the future, that one priest will not be able to offer the Masses Fr Nathaniel and I offer in the four churches every weekend. For the time being, we continue to pray for more vocations to the priesthood and we appreciate the blessings we have in the present.

BAPTISM

Diocesan policy requires that the Pastor be contacted at least 6 months before the anticipated date of marriage to allow time for premarital inventory, instructions, and planning.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This feast day commemorates Mary's body and soul taken directly to heaven.



WELLNESS MINUTE

Breathwork offers significant mental and physical health benefits, by activating the parasympathetic nervous system or the "rest and digest" state. Slowly breathe in your nose and let yourself feel the peace spreading through you. Slowly breathe out the tension and the anxieties when meditating on God's word.

A specific technique is to pair one part of a prayer with the inhale and the other with the exhale. For instance, when you say the Jesus prayer, inhale slowly, quietly saying "Jesus Christ, Son of God" and exhale saying "have mercy on me, a sinner." Repeat the process until you feel relaxed.

When one consistently practices prayer with breathwork, it becomes a simple and effective habit to calm your body and focus your mind on Christ. Then, when a stressful situation arises, you are spiritually prepared. If you find yourself in a situation that feels overwhelming, become aware of your breath and start praying. "Pray without ceasing." (1 Thes 5:17) and keep God's presence in your daily life.
