A NOTE FROM FATHER NATHANIEL

When you have received the Body of Christ at Mass, have you ever wondered "do I truly receive every part of Jesus or do I simply receive his body, but not his blood?" When a person receives a fragment of the sacred host, does this mean that we only receive part of Jesus? How does the Catholic Church understand the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist? As Catholics, we believe that when we receive Jesus in the sacred host, we receive all of Jesus: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. The same is true if we receive the precious blood. This reality is called **Concomitance** and it is "the doctrine that explains why the whole Christ is present under each eucharistic species." You see, God cannot be separated; He is indivisible! Wherever God is, he is completely present there. It is impossible to say that the body of Jesus is present in the eucharistic host but not his blood, just as it is impossible to say that only the blood of Jesus is present in the precious blood in the chalice. Rather, whenever we receive the Eucharist, body or blood, we can be confident that we receive all of Jesus into our soul. It is true that receiving the Eucharist under both species allows "the sign of the Eucharistic Banquet to be made more fully evident." However, in places where circumstance make the reception of the Holy Communion under both species difficult, we can be confident that we still receive the whole Jesus: Body Blood, Soul and Divinity, in the Eucharistic Host.

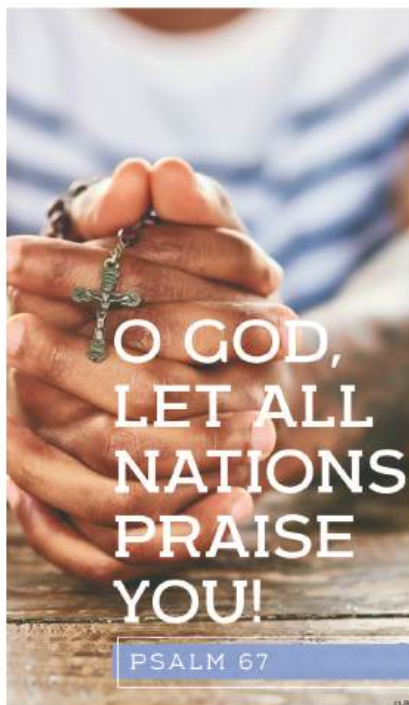
Stewardship as a Way of Life: *"For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable."* - Romans 11:29

WELLNESS MINUTE



St. Maximillian Kolbe (1894-1941) was a Franciscan friar and priest, best known for volunteering to take the place of a prisoner with a family in Auschwitz, Nazi Germany's largest concentration/extermination camp. He was executed by a lethal injection after being starved. John 15:13: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends" best describes his martyrdom during World War II. St. Kolbe is the patron saint of drug addicts as his calm, prayerful endurance in the starvation bunker is a powerful witness of spiritual freedom from physical bondage, needed for those in recovery. His legacy continues to inspire and guide us, showing true devotion often comes with a call to deep sacrifice. St. Kolbe founded the Militia of the Immaculata (meaning the "Army of the Immaculate One"), whose aim was to fight evil with the witness of the good life, prayer, work, and suffering. He also created the *Knight of the Immaculata*, a religious magazine under Mary's protection to preach the Good News to all nations. St. Kolbe's life is a testament to unconditional love and courage in the face of evil. His holiness was a limitless, passionate desire to convert the whole world to God.
