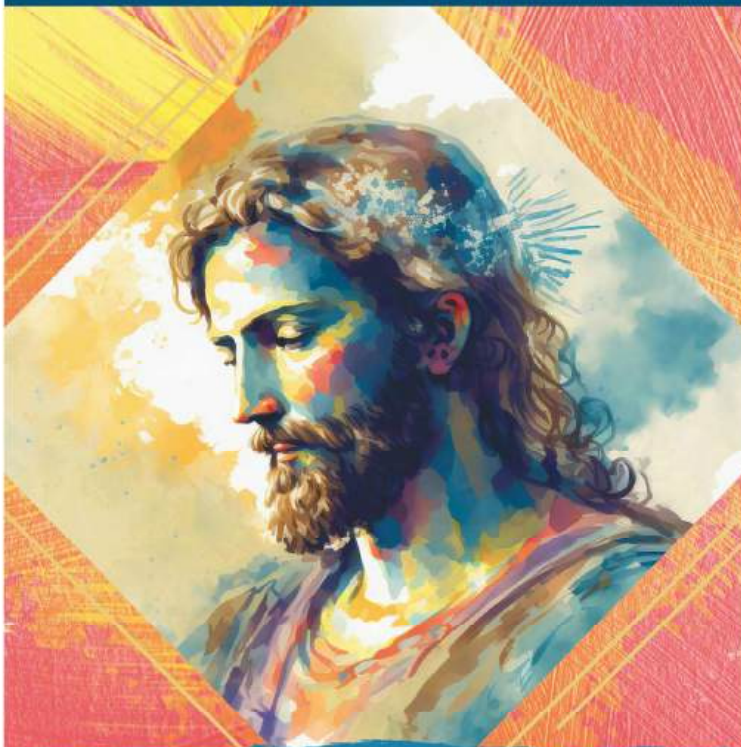

Fostering the Domestic Church: Articulating What's Important

We are just days away from the start of another school year. For many families, this brings a significant change in routine. This season can feel especially chaotic as individuals and families adjust to new schedules, activities, and responsibilities.

As I reflected on this changing season and the challenges that come with changes to our daily routines, I wondered, *"When are individuals and families not busy or juggling something new?"* Many of us would probably say that life is always busy and there is always something going on.

So how do we find time for the things that are important? One of the first steps is simply identifying what is important. Is it important to say goodbye to one another before leaving for the day? To pray before bed? To share a meal together? To attend Sunday Mass? When we recognize that something is truly important, we are more likely to intentionally make time for it.

Family Goal: Write down two or three things that are important to you as an individual and two or three things that are important for your family. Then ask: *Are we making time for the things that matter most?*

BAPTISM

Contact the parish offices. Requirements for having your first child baptized are: registration at a parish and attendance of a pre-baptism class. The pre-baptism class is typically offered the 3rd Saturday of the month. Pre-registration is required.

Diocesan policy requires that the Pastor be contacted at least 6 months before the anticipated date of marriage to allow time for premarital inventory, instructions, and planning.

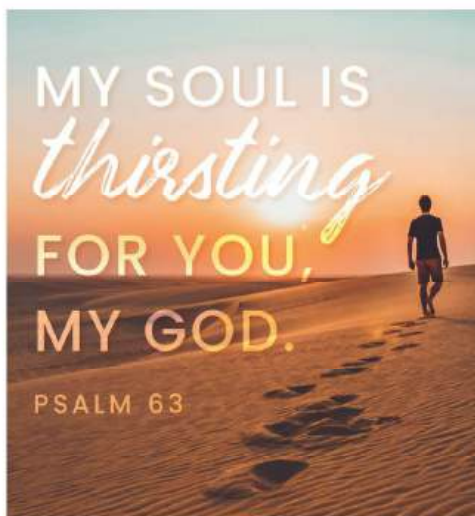

WELLNESS MINUTE

How does one cope with grief and heal? Grief can affect us physically, emotionally, and spiritually, and everyone's journey through grief is unique. Because we're human, we don't get a "free pass." Even Jesus wept at the death of his friend, Lazarus. (John 11:35) The more we love, the more we suffer. Grief is love enduring. C.S. Lewis writes, "The pain now is part of the happiness then." Would we want it any other way? Revelation 21:4 offers the promise of eternal healing: God will wipe away every tear and eliminate death, mourning, and pain. In the midst of loss, find healing ways to provide comfort and grow from it:

- Allow time to mourn, acknowledging the pain rather than suppressing it with denial or distractions.
- Trust in the hope of the Resurrection to carry you through this journey of loss.
- Seek parish and/or community support and lean on family and friends to avoid isolation.
- Transform pain into prayer by engaging in the Rosary, Adoration, and Masses for loved ones.

God is close to the broken hearted and bigger than your grief. Mourning and suffering are a healthy response to love. Move forward with your loved one safe in your heart knowing God is by your side.

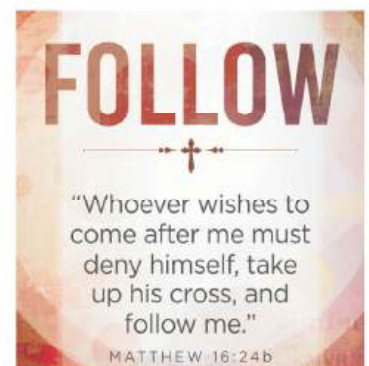
