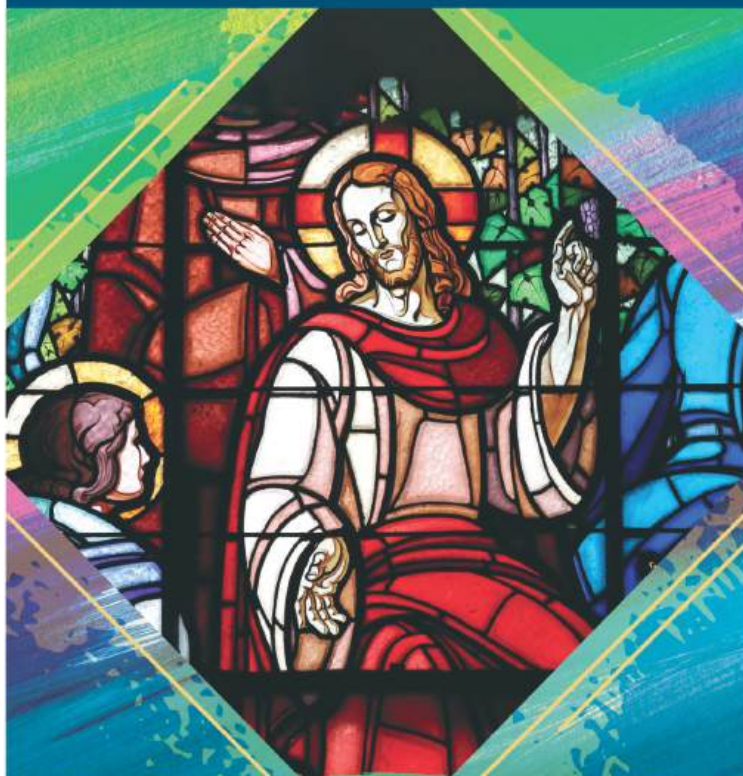

A Note from Father Omar:

Grace is the free and undeserved help that God gives us to respond to his call to become children of God, partakers of the divine nature and of eternal life. Amazing! God calls us and also gives us what we need to respond to his call. This makes me think of the time when I felt God's call to the priesthood and how He sent the signs to encourage me to say Yes.

Another grace is Habitual Grace: the permanent disposition to live and act in keeping with God's call. As one priest once said: perseverance is the name of the game! Our perseverance is also blessed by the gift of grace. The Church also teaches about Sacramental graces, which are the gifts proper to the different Sacraments. If we are faithful to the Mass every week, we are recipients of extra graces. If we go to Confession regularly, we are vessels of special graces.

Finally, if we are faithful in our commitment to the Lord, we will receive Sanctifying grace, which is, a stable and supernatural disposition that perfects the soul itself to enable it to live with God and to act by His love. This is the grace the saints received, and it is available to all of us. Persevere!

BAPTISM

WELLNESS MINUTE

September is Suicide Awareness month. Suicide is the intentional act of ending one's life. Many who think of suicide want to escape intense emotional or physical pain. They feel hopeless, lonely, ashamed or overwhelmed from trauma, bullying or other issues. As Christians, our hope is in the Resurrection. "The sufferings of this time are not worthy to be compared with the glory to come." (Rom 8.18).



We must be aware of those around us (family, school, work, and church) who might be having suicidal thoughts, showing signs of depression or anxiety, isolating themselves, or exhibiting other negative habits. If you suspect someone at risk, create a safe space to talk without fear of judgment. Stay with the person if they are at immediate risk and **call 911**. If you or a loved one is struggling with thoughts of suicide **call or text 988**, the National Suicide and Crisis Lifeline for free, confidential support 24/7. The Ottertail County Mobile Mental Health Crisis Line is also available at **1-800-223-4512**.

Created in his image means we are to reflect God's mercy and compassion for those who die by suicide and survivors. We must break the silence; foster safe, connected parishes where people are comfortable discussing suicide. St Peter said, "Cast all your worries upon Him because he cares for you." (1 PT 5:7)

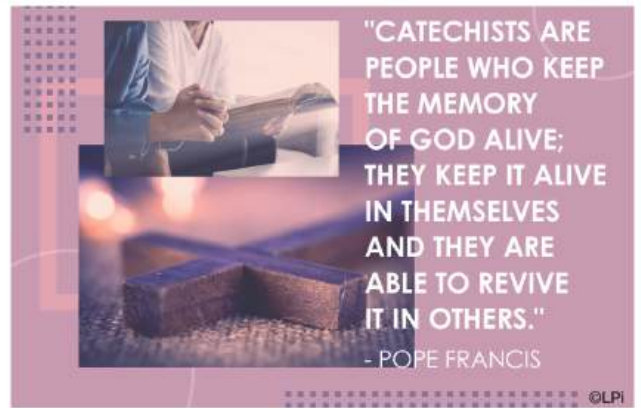

Catechetical Sunday: September 20, 2026

Catechetical Sunday is celebrated annually on the third Sunday in September in the United States to honor those who serve as catechists and to reflect on the role of all baptized members in sharing the faith. It provides an opportunity for parishes to recognize the importance of faith formation and encourage the community to rededicate themselves to spreading the Gospel. The theme for 2026 is: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me... to bring good news to the poor" (Lk 4:18; cf. Is 61:1), highlighting Jesus' mission and calling the Church to continue His work by sharing hope, healing, and mercy. This day emphasizes both the ministry of catechists and the responsibility of all Christians to witness to the faith in daily life.



St. Pius of Pietrelcina - Feast Day September 23

St. Pius of Pietrelcina, known as Padre Pio, was born Francesco Forgione in Italy in 1887. A Capuchin Franciscan priest, he was marked by illness, deep prayer, and the stigmata. Serving in San Giovanni Rotondo, he devoted long days to Mass, confession, and blessing the sick. He inspired the Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza hospital and was canonized in 2002. St. Pius of Pietrelcina, pray for us!
