
As per our discussion, I will allow a low water crossing to be built in the Tyson Wash on 53rd Street with the following stipulations:

- You obtain a 404 Permit from the Army Corp. of Engineers.
- You follow the La Paz County Standards, Standard #5-380 Concrete Cut-Off Walls with the Concrete Surface Ford.
- Have it surveyed and engineered for a vertical alignment and to determine where the 1 (one) foot above high water level would be.



53rd Street, Tyson Wash crossing

High water bank-to-bank span is 84 ft. With roadway width of 33 ft. the area equals 2,772 sq. ft., or .064 acres. Falls within US Army Corps of Engineers 404 Nationwide Permit No.14, 84 ft.

La Paz County roadway ROW = 33 ft.
