Description of Proposed Recipients

The Mother Church Developing Areas Fund provides financial assistance for projects that advance Christian Science in designated areas (Africa, Asia, Latin America).

High Ridge House provides full nursing care as well as rest and study options.

The Christian Science Monitor Endowment Fund supports the present and future needs of The CS Monitor.

Chestnut Hill Benevolent Association provides full care, visiting nurse services, rest and study options, nurses training school, and independent living.

The Principle Foundation offers immediate short-term financial aid in the form of grants.

National Fund for Christian Science Nursing provides grants to assist in meeting the costs for Christian Science nursing care. It is a restricted, separate fund within the Principle Foundation.

Beacon Haven offers full care, outpatient services, rest and study and visiting CS nursing.

Clearview Home Corporation offers full care, outpatient care, and rest and study options.

Glenmont provides full care as well as rest and study options.

Peace Haven provides full care, skilled inpatient care, visiting nursing services, outpatient care, assistance for mothers/infants, rest and study options.

Visiting Christian Science Nursing Care of Greater Chicago is the new activity of Hill Top Center and serves the metropolitan Chicago area, Southern Wisconsin and NW Indiana.

Upward Wing provides CS nursing service.

The Campership Fund for Christian Scientists provides financial assistance to Christian Scientists in the US and Canada to attend one of six CS camps.

Twelveacres, Inc provides residential housing for adults seeking healing through Christian Science.

The Leaves provides in-patient and out-patient nursing services, rest and study options.

The Albert Baker Fund provides post-secondary scholarships to Christian Scientists.

Christian Science National Benevolent Fund provides financial assistance for nursing costs.

CherishAbility supports Christian Scientists with developmental special needs and their families.
