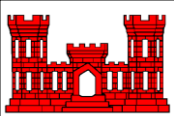

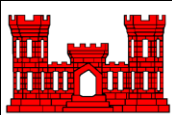


**Title:** FSC 107 January IDT (MUTA 4)

**Key Points of Training:**

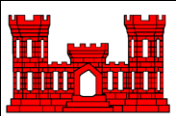
Training focused on Drivers training, Battle Drill 2, TLP's, SINGAR's and SKL Training.
