Random thoughts, musing and news about the reunion and Association in general, as they pop into the head of ye' ole editor:

DICK WILLS is living in the Jacobetti Veteran's Hospital in Marquette. He was at the reunion last year in Marquette talking to everybody. He sat down with Tom Vukonich to help Tom out with his research of the 254th Engineer Battalion in WW II. He is the only WW II vet that I heard from last year. He is 97 years old, in pretty good health and doing well.

Last year we had four former members of HHC attend the reunion for the first time; COL(ret) Greg Krot, CW4(ret) Rick Bohlinger, CW4(ret) Phil Cooke, SSG(ret) Brent Hadfield. They were members of the aviation section way back in the 1970's, when HHC had a section of helicopters as part of the MTOE.

There were six former battalion commanders and one former CSM in attendance at last year's reunion. This is in addition to the current battalion commander and CSM.

If my memory serves me correctly, there are 14 former BC's and 4 former CSM's still living. Can you name all of them?

There are a lot of family stories related to service in the 107th Engineer Battalion and MIARNG. There is a pair of battalion retiree family members who between them have served a combined 80 years in the MIARNG. Can you name them? Hint: they are brothers. CSM(ret) Mike Floriano and CW5(ret) Joe Floriano served a combined 80 years in the MIARNG. I'm going to guess that 90+% of that time was spent in the 107th. They both also made it to the top enlisted and warrant officer rank respectively. These two outstanding Soldiers are good examples of why the 107th has such a great reputation in the MIARNG and beyond.

Are you a history buff or know someone who may be interested in organizing or cataloging our collection of historical items? The Association has a lot of historical documents, pictures and memorabilia. It is stored at the Ishpeming Armory, my garage and other places. It seems a shame not to have this history on display or available for the public to enjoy. Perhaps we should turn our collection over to a historical society or museum to be cataloged and displayed. We've got pictures, paperwork, WW II items donated by the WW II vets and lots of other “stuff.” I will probably bring this topic up for discussion at the 2017 business meeting at the reunion in Iron River this summer.

Speaking of history research, in the last 5-10 years we have had a number of children of battalion WW II veterans attending the reunion (and joining the Association). They have been going through some of our WW II archives to research what their fathers did in WW II. Almost to a person, they tell me that their fathers told them very little about their war experiences. Even Ed Vickstrom told me one time that he wished he had told his children more about his war experiences. But those guys came back home, went to work, started families and drove on. To them, it was more important to look ahead instead of dwelling on the past. Now that the children are getting to retirement age they have time to spend researching their fathers WW II exploits.

16 July 2016

Call to order at 1050 hrs by Jake Nyquist. 24 Members present. 2015 business meeting minutes read. Motion to approve: Joe Testolin, Second: Bob Groop. Motion carried.

2015 treasurer's report read. Motion to approve: Jim Dougovito, Second: Joel Jarvi. Motion carried.

Lineage and Honors Committee Report No report. The purpose of this committee is to capture the activities and mobilizations of the battalion since September 11, 2001. We are soliciting volunteers to gather info and data about each of the different platoons and companies that deployed. If you want to help in this effort, please contact Tom Perry or Perry Nora.

Old Business:

1. The website fees have been paid by SFC(ret) Ross Stevens (Co A/1431st retiree). Ross said he was not worried about the financial responsibilities for owning and maintaining the website. He considers it a part of his support for the Association. He is also the technical consultant to keep the website running properly.
2. Follow-up on graphic design work to show all the shoulder patches of the organizations which the battalion units have served with in the Global War on Terror(GWOT) is still a goal but not making much progress.
3. Follow-up regarding the battalion plaque in the regimental room at the Fort Leonard Wood museum. LTC Scott House, outgoing battalion commander said WO1(former Bn CSM) Rob Jeannotte is currently at Ft Leonard Wood, MO. He will provide an update upon his return. Tom Perry will contact him for the update. (\$3000 was appropriated at the Gladstone reunion to fund the plaque project.)

New Business:

1. Nominate Det 1, 1432nd Engineer Company in Iron River as the location for the 2017 reunion. Motion to approve: Rob Sexton, Second by Dave Rye. Motion carried.
2. Dates for 56th annual reunion. There was considerable confusion about dates for Annual Training for 2017 which could/would conflict with the reunion dates.. Therefore, no dates were selected for the reunion at this time. A motion was made by Jim Dougovito to authorize Tom Perry to coordinate with the unit and set dates for the 2017 reunion and post them to the website. Seconded by Jim Hutcheson. Motion carried.

5. The 107th Engineer Battalion monument at Camp Grayling(CG) is in need of repainting and possibly some minor repairs. A motion was made by Mike Floriano and seconded by Joe Testolin to authorize up to \$500 for the maintenance of the monument. Tom Perry will check with CG facility engineering to see if they are authorized to pay those repairs, thus saving us the money.(Note after the fact: CG does not have funding for this project.) Tom Perry will contact Patton Monuments, the original vendor for the monument, for a proposal to do the work.
6. There was some discussion as to whether or not there will be a battalion officers call this October. The matter was referred to the incoming battalion commander and staff to resolve.
7. Mike Fraser informed the Association that Bill Sheldon's wife Barb donated \$1000 to the Ishpeming NCO Club to be used for a memorial in his honor at the Ishpeming Armory.
8. Pete Injasoulian informed the Association that the former Retired Officers Association of Michigan is now the Retired Association of Michigan. The change was made to allow for retired enlisted National Guard members to join.
