107<sup>th</sup> Engineer Association Business Meeting Minutes Iron River, MI 12 August 2017

Called to order at 1250 hrs by President Jake Pfiester. 22 Members present. President Pfiester provided details of the afternoon and evening festivities.

2016 business meeting minutes read. Motion to approve by Joe Testolin, second by Joel Jarvi. Motion carried.

2016-2017 treasurers' report presented. Motion by Joel Jarvi, second by Joe Testolin. Motion carried.

Lineage and Honors Committee Report No report. The purpose of this committee is to capture the activities and mobilizations of the battalion since September 11, 2001. We are soliciting volunteers to gather info and data about each of the different platoons and companies that deployed. If you want to help in this effort, please contact Tom Perry or Perry Nora. LTC Gillahan, Bn Cdr, has also tasked CSM Perez to assist in this effort.

#### Old Business:

- 1. The website fees have been paid by SFC(ret) Ross Stevens (Co A/1431st retiree). Ross said he was not worried about the financial responsibilities for owning and maintaining the website. He considers it a part of his support for the Association. He is also the technical consultant to keep the website running properly.
- 2. Follow-up on graphic design work to show all the shoulder patches of the organizations which the battalion units have served with in the Global War on Terror(GWOT) is still a goal but not making much progress.
- 3. Follow-up regarding the battalion plaque in the regimental room at the Fort Leonard Wood museum. LTC Dave Gillahan, battalion commander, asked for one more year to accomplish this mission. (\$3000 was appropriated at the Gladstone reunion(2015) to fund the plaque project. If we are not going to participate in this project, we should de-obligate the money.)
- 4. The 107th Engineer Battalion monument at Camp Grayling(CG) is in need of repainting and possibly some minor repairs. A motion was made by Mike Floriano and seconded by Joe Testolin to authorize up to \$500 for the maintenance of the monument. Tom Perry will contact Patton Monuments, the original vendor for the monument, for a proposal to do the work. This was a carryover item from last year. Tom Perry committed to get it done before the next reunion.

- 1. Nominate HSC, 107th Engineer Battalion in Ishpeming as the location for the 2018 reunion. This will be the tenth anniversary of the HSC/FSC return from mobilization in Iraq. Motion by Joe Floriano, second by Bob Groop. Motion carried.
- 2. Dates for 57th annual reunion were set for 14-15 Sep 2018. Motion by Butch DeVerney, second by Joe Floriano. Motion carried. After the reunion, the dates were changed to 7-8 Sep 18 because of conflicts with the unit training requirements.
