Welcome to Ironwood, former home of Co B, 107th Engineer Bn

The Company B Alumni, 107th Engineer Bn, Ironwood, would like to cordially invite you to the 63rd annual reunion of the 107th Engineer Association. The retired Soldiers and family of the Ironwood unit look forward to hosting this long-standing traditional gathering of the Association. This year's reunion will be 1-2 August 2025 in Ironwood, Michigan. The reunion will be headquartered at the American Legion Post #5, 320 East McLeod Ave, Ironwood, Michigan 49938.

On Friday, 1 Aug, beginning at 1400 hrs (all times CDT) registration will commence. This is a great time to catch up with old friends, and get to know new faces. The bar will be open in the American Legion Post 5 in Ironwood. At 1800 hrs the social mixer will kick off with food, sponsored by and compliments of the Company B Alumni from Ironwood. Bar services will be available.

On Saturday at 0800-0930 hrs breakfast will be served By Barry (Bucky) Koljonen and helpers. Breakfast will be SOS, scrambled eggs, sausage and toast. Cost is \$10 per person.

As it is customary, we will meet at the flagpole at 1030 hrs for the Memorial Service at the American Legion (Memorial Building – Ironwood, MI). Immediately after the Memorial Service, there will be the annual business meeting downstairs in the American Legion Hall. Following the business meeting, we will have lunch in the Memorial Building – American Legion Hall. Bar services will again be available. Lunch will consist of hamburgers and brats on a Blackstone grill cooked by SFC Davis. Cost will be \$10 per person.

We encourage you to explore the western Upper Peninsula and Gogebic County. Copper Peak is approximately 7 miles north of Ironwood and offers chairlift rides to the top of the jump which overlooks the county and on a clear day you can see Canada across Lake Superior. There are many

waterfalls throughout the area, including Iron County Wisconsin. Ironwood is also home to the world's tallest Indian – Hiawatha. Little Girls Point and Black River Harbor are on Lake Superior and well worth the drive to visit also. The city of Ironwood will be conducting tours through its Historic Memorial Building after lunch Saturday. There are local campgrounds to choose from – Alpine on US2 in Bessemer, Sunday Lake Park – Wakefield, Curry Park Ironwood (next to the fairgrounds). and Saxon Harbor area has two campsites available – Frontier Bar and the Harbor itself. Area motels will be offering a specific government rate. A list of discounted hotels will follow shortly.

The day's events will lead up to the annual banquet. Cocktails will begin at 1700 hrs at the American Legion Bar and colors will be posted at 1800 hrs. Immediately following the introduction of the reunion committee and the honored guests, there will be a dinner meal. The cost will be \$25 per person.

Please RSVP as soon as possible so that we may adequately plan for the weekend's activities. Please let us know numbers attending for all meals so we can order our food appropriately.
