- 1. Tzvi's father contracted a terminal illness. It reached a point where the doctors thought he wouldn't make it through the night. Tzvi emailed a request for a blessing to be delivered to the Rebbe King Moshiach Shlita in 770 Eastern Parkway. That night, to the astonishment of the doctors, his father's condition significantly improved the complete opposite of their predictions! He went on to fully recover, and is now going strong in his nineties!
- 2. Tzvi works as an accountant for a generous family who contributes to countless Jewish organizations and individuals. Recently the philanthropist's wife was hospitalized as it seemed that she had undergone a stroke. Tzvi sent in a request for blessing to the Rebbe King Moshiach Shlita in 770 Eastern Parkway. The doctors then discovered that it was not a stroke but rather a heart problem, from which she recovered.

Moshiach * Healthy Lifestyle

Imagine a world with no sickness. The Rambam (Rabbi Maimonides) includes this in his description of the times of Moshiach. The Rambam was also a professional doctor and included instructions for healthy living in his code of Jewish law, because we need to be healthy to serve G-d. The Rebbe King Moshiach Shlita says that in the Redemption, everyone will follow the Rambam's health guidelines, ensuring perfect health. Here are some of the things the Rambam says to do to be healthy:

- Do not eat until your stomach is completely full; rather, eat about a quarter less than full satiation.
- In the summer, one needs to eat 2/3 of the amount that one eats during the winter.
- Be active. This is even more important than avoiding unhealthy foods.

Insight * Caring About Each Other

Some Jews are business people and professionals, whose main Jewish expression is giving Tzedakah (but also set times to learn Torah). Others work in spiritual fields, spending most of their time on Torah learning (but also give Tzedakah). Even though we are different from each other, we are all one nation, and we all care about each other. Each of the 12 spies in this week's Torah portion toured the *entire* land, not only the portion of his own tribe, because they cared about all the other tribes and wanted to see that all of their portions were good. We express our love and unity with our fellow Jews by thinking about what others need, spiritually and physically, and providing for them. We also unite in Tzedakah by giving on behalf of others, and in Torah learning by teaching others, joining the Rambam study-cycle and spreading the teachings of Chassidus – the knowledge of G-d – to all corners of the world. Practical Judaism * Blessings on Foods

We learned the blessings on bread last week. For other foods: "Baruch Atah Ado-nai Elo-heinu Melech HaOlam...

Cake/Cookies/Pasta/Oatmeal/Doughnuts etc. made from wheat/barley/oats/rye/spelt (but not bread): "...Borei Minei Mezonos." Wine/Grape Juice (also must be Kosher-certified): "...Borei Pri Hagafen." Fruits/nuts that grow on a tree: "...Borei Pri Hagafen." Vegetables that grow from the ground (including fruits that grow on plants that are not considered to be actual trees, such as bananas): "...Borei Pri Ha'adamah." Most drinks, candies, animal products etc.: "...Shehakol Niheyah Bidvaro."

Kosher Recipe * Tropical Celery Salad

Because this salad includes foods from two categories of blessings (fruits and vegetables), we recommend making blessings and eating some of a different fruit and a different vegetable first.



A Few Stalks Celery – washed very well and checked for bugs, sliced

1 Mango or Starfruit, cut into small chunks

Small Chunk of Red Onion, diced

Juice of ½ Lime

Salt to taste

Dash Ginger Powder

Toss all ingredients together. If you have time, let it sit for a while for the flavors to blend.
