Join your CBTU sisters and brothers who are coming together Saturday, Oct. 24th, for a National Day of Action. Help us pump up the volume in our communities for a huge turnout of Black voters at the ballot box. Here is how you can get involved:

Collective Actions

- Contact your local CBTU chapter leadership for “Just Vote” yard signs and window signs
- Organize car caravans with “JUST VOTE” signs on the doors
- Distribute CBTU yard signs/pose with homeowner(s)
- Get permission to put CBTU signs in storefront windows
- Partner with other groups to distribute voter education leaflets, doorhanger, etc.

We know many CBTU members will be reluctant to participate in outdoor group activities. They can still participate in the National Day of Action from home or with family members.

Individual Actions

- Early vote with a family member as part of Make a Family Plan
- Post selfies of “I Just Voted”
- Create videos saying why voting in this election is important
- Download and post the Just Vote poster on www.cbtuvote.org on social media sites (Facebook, Instagram, WhatsApp, etc.)
- Phonebank from home along with other CBTU election volunteers
- Contact 10 family members for a “vote check-in”
- Share messages and photos on social media with the CBTU hashtags #justvote and #CBTUGoodTrouble #NationalDayofAction
