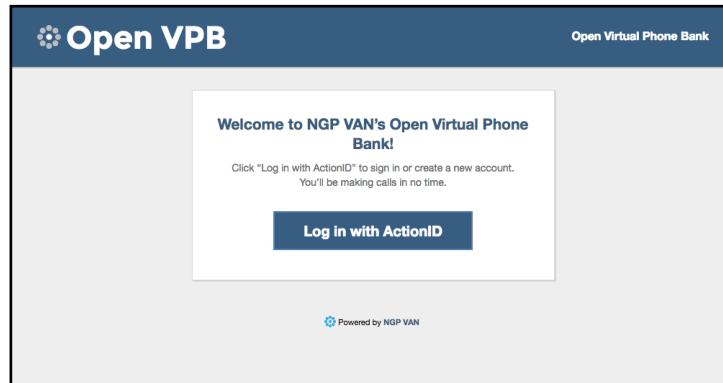
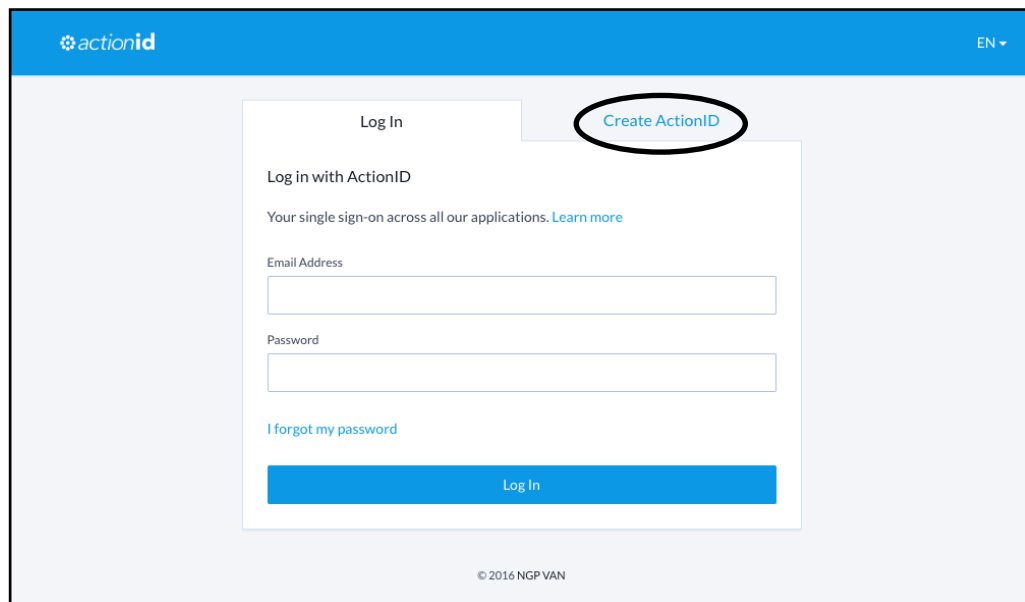


How to Phone Bank from Home

- ▶ Go to OpenVPB.com, then click on “Log in with ActionID”



- ▶ If this is your first time using OpenVPB.com, select “Create ActionID”; otherwise use the ActionID you previously created.



- ▶ Fill in your information. You'll be sent a confirmation email after clicking "Create".
 - ▶ It will give you a choice to use Two-Step Verification. This is an optional security feature, but you should take advantage of it for good measure.

Early Vote begins on Thursday, October 20 and ends on Saturday, November 5th.

Will you be early voting during this election?

Did you know that there were six black candidates running for elected offices statewide?
Having six Black candidates on a ballot has never been done before in North Carolina, so this ballot has become a part of history. It is imperative that we ensure that they are elected this November.

Would you support these six black candidates running for statewide office, including Misa Morgan for state Supreme Court, Linda Coleman for Lt. Governor and Den Blue III for state treasurer?

We are really encouraging people to vote the entire ballot this election. In addition to these sensational six candidates, have you considered who you will vote for Governor and President?
Will you be voting for Hillary Clinton or Donald Trump for President?

If the election for Governor were being held today, would you support the Democrat, Roy Cooper, or the Republican Pat McCrory?

Roy Cooper and Hillary Clinton are running on the same ticket as the six black candidates statewide. So again, we encourage you to vote the whole ticket from top to bottom! While the Presidential Election is first, there are 3 of the 6 Black candidates who are running for statewide judgeships to help change our justice system, which are at the bottom of the ballot.

One last question - Would you be interested in joining us in encouraging other people in the black community to get out and vote?

Are you interested in volunteering to get your neighborhood out to vote this fall?

[Yes] - Great! We are working weekly out of our local office off of _____ road, specifically at _____. Let me make sure we have the correct phone number for you, so we can contact you about volunteering. (Check their number on the list or add their number if it isn't there or they aren't on the list)

[No] - I want to thank you for giving your time to talk with us! [Move to closing statement]
Thanks again for being a voter this year - this will be a critical election and I'm glad we agree that voting is important.
We may get in touch after you vote to see how your experience went at the polls and ask you to get involved with our local Advance Carolina chapter in order to continue building capacity for the advancement of Black communities in our state.
