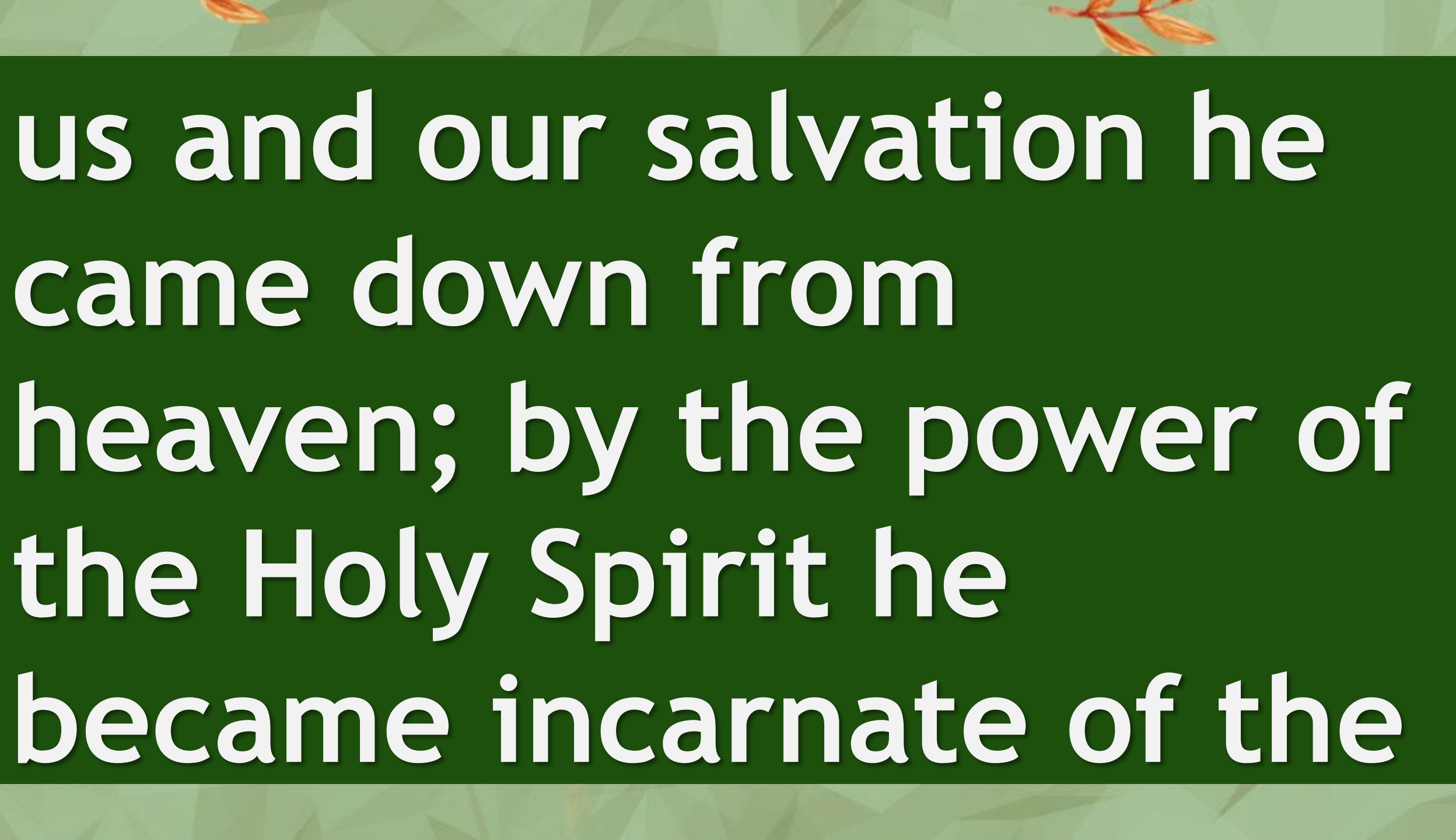
We believe in one God,

God, Light from Light,



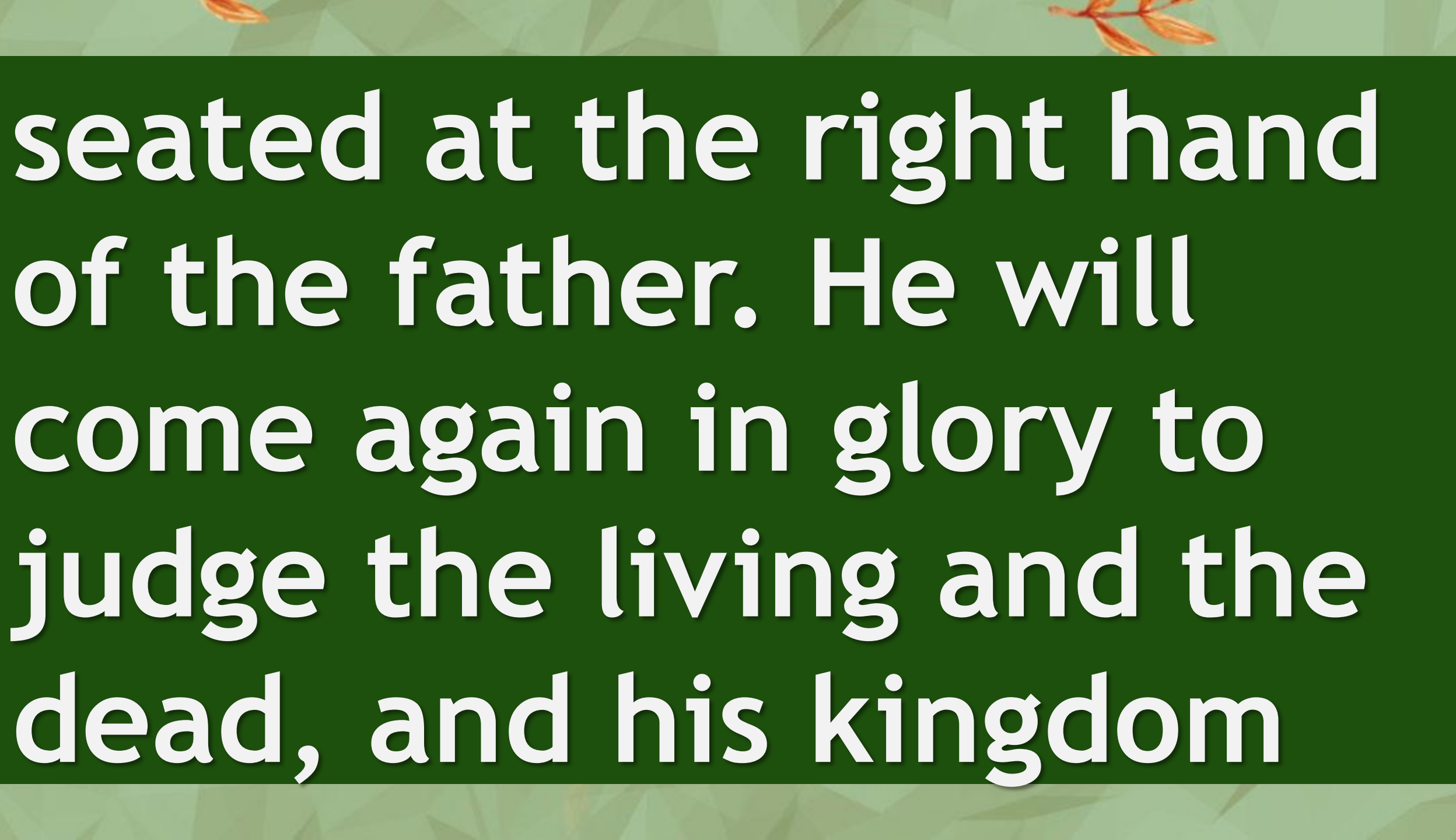
true God from true God,

Virgin Mary, and became truly human. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was

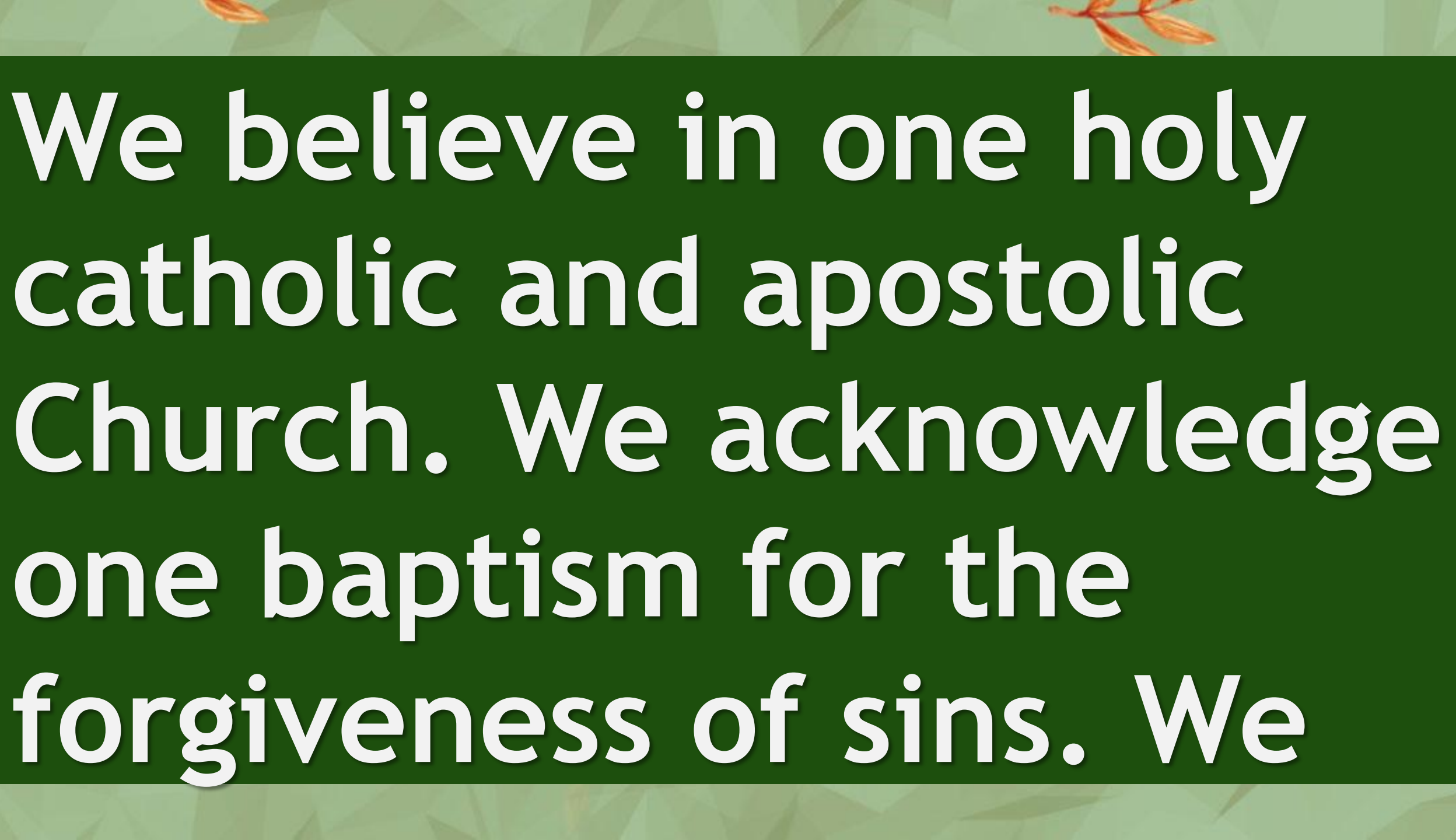
buried. On the third day

into heaven and is



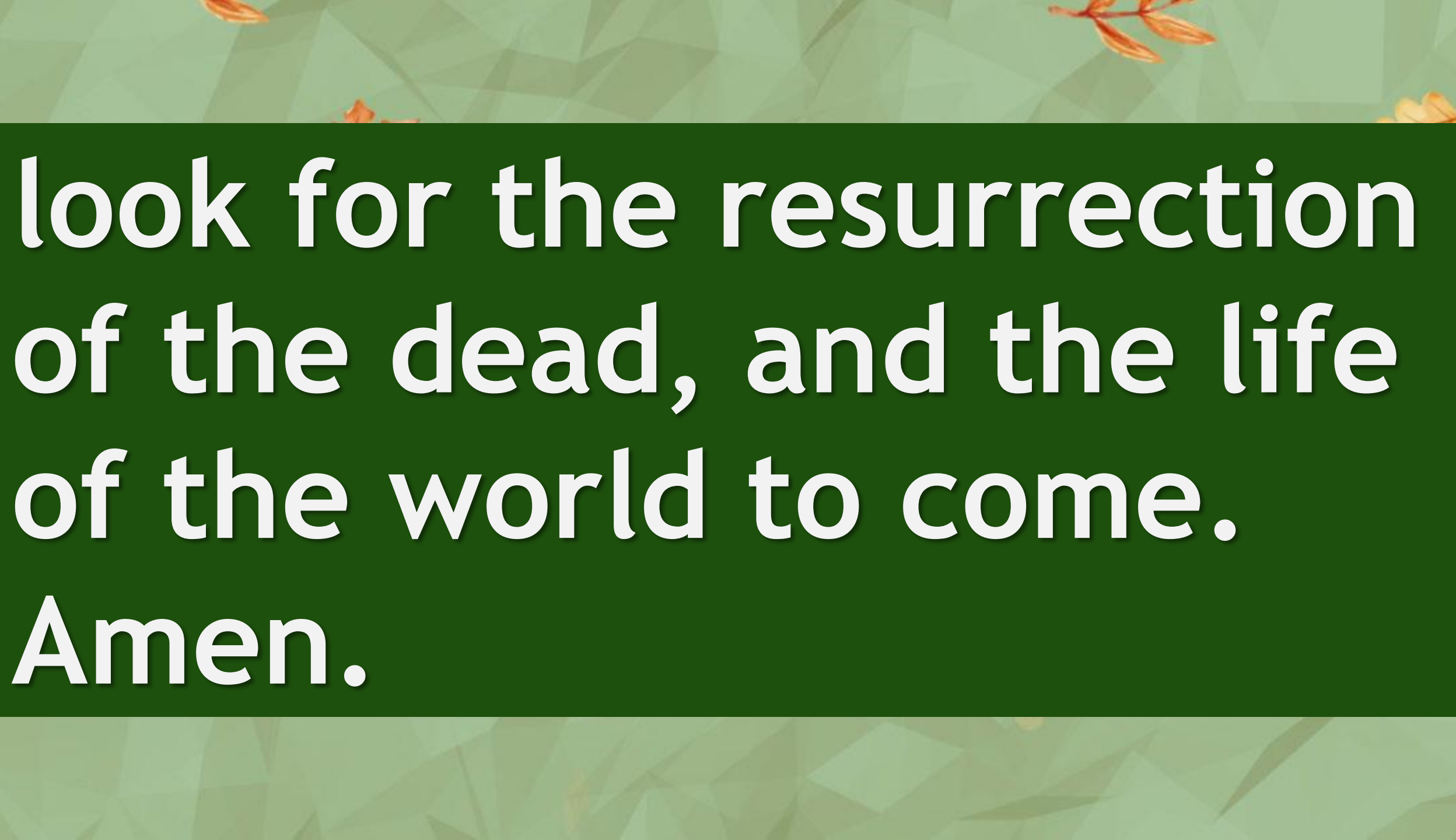
seated at the right hand
