


Gracious Father, whose love is powerful enough to break us loose from sin's control: Transform our lives by a revelation of love in Christ that







go into the city, and you will be told what you must do."





Because He lives, I can face tomorrow; because He lives, all fear is gone; because I know He holds the future, and life is worth the living just because He lives.




How sweet to hold a newborn baby, And feel the pride and joy he gives.
