

We gather today, in the name of the One who gives all the opportunity for repentance that leads to life.


We gather today, in the name of the One whose command created all things.


Winter, spring, summer, fall. In every season, you are worthy of worship. In good times and bad, sorrow and joy. In all circumstances, you are

worthy of worship. When we feel distant from you or can feel the warmth of your love surrounding us. Whatever our feelings, you are worthy of worship.


Today, in all things, you are worthy of worship. And so, we come to you as we are, and give you our worship and praise. This is all for you. Receive our worship.
