








Lord, righteousness makes a path for you into our lives. Let us hear your words to us this day. In other words, passionate love and consistent faithfulness come


together. Right living for individuals and peace among communities join hands. Surround us with your grace on all sides, from above and below. Amen.





ADVIEL HOPE PEACE






Come, thou long expected Jesus, Born to set thy people free; From our fears and sins release us, Let us find our rest in thee.

By thine own eternal spirit rule in all our hearts alone; by thine all sufficient merit, raise us to thy glorious throne.







Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Ghost; as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. Amen.




Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing
