the people had been weeping as they listened to the words of the Law. ¹⁰ Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those



who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."




