# Opening Prayer (unison)



As we come into the house of the Lord today, let us do so with reverence. Let us recognize the greatness and glory of the one we worship. Let us celebrate that we can


come just as we are, and yet, let us come before him with humility. It is no small thing to worship the Lord our God. Let us worship in gratitude and awe!






