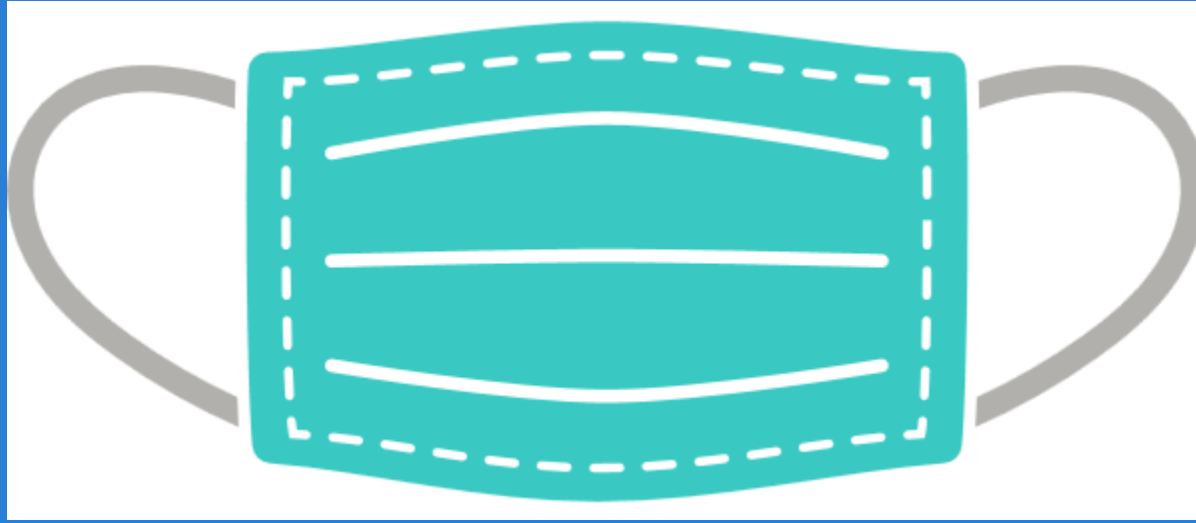

ARE YOU TITHING?

An easy way to know is to
look at your tax return

\$18,650	11	Subtract line 10c from line 9. This is your adjusted gross income	11

Form **1040** (2020)

Take the amount on line 15
Taxable Income and divide by 520
to find your tithing amount per week.

EXAMPLES

$$\$30,000 / 520 = \$58/\text{week}$$

$$\$50,000 / 520 = \$95/\text{week}$$

$$\$70,000 / 520 = \$135/\text{week}$$

$$\$90,000 / 520 = \$173/\text{week}$$

Pastor: Gather and praise the God of our salvation.

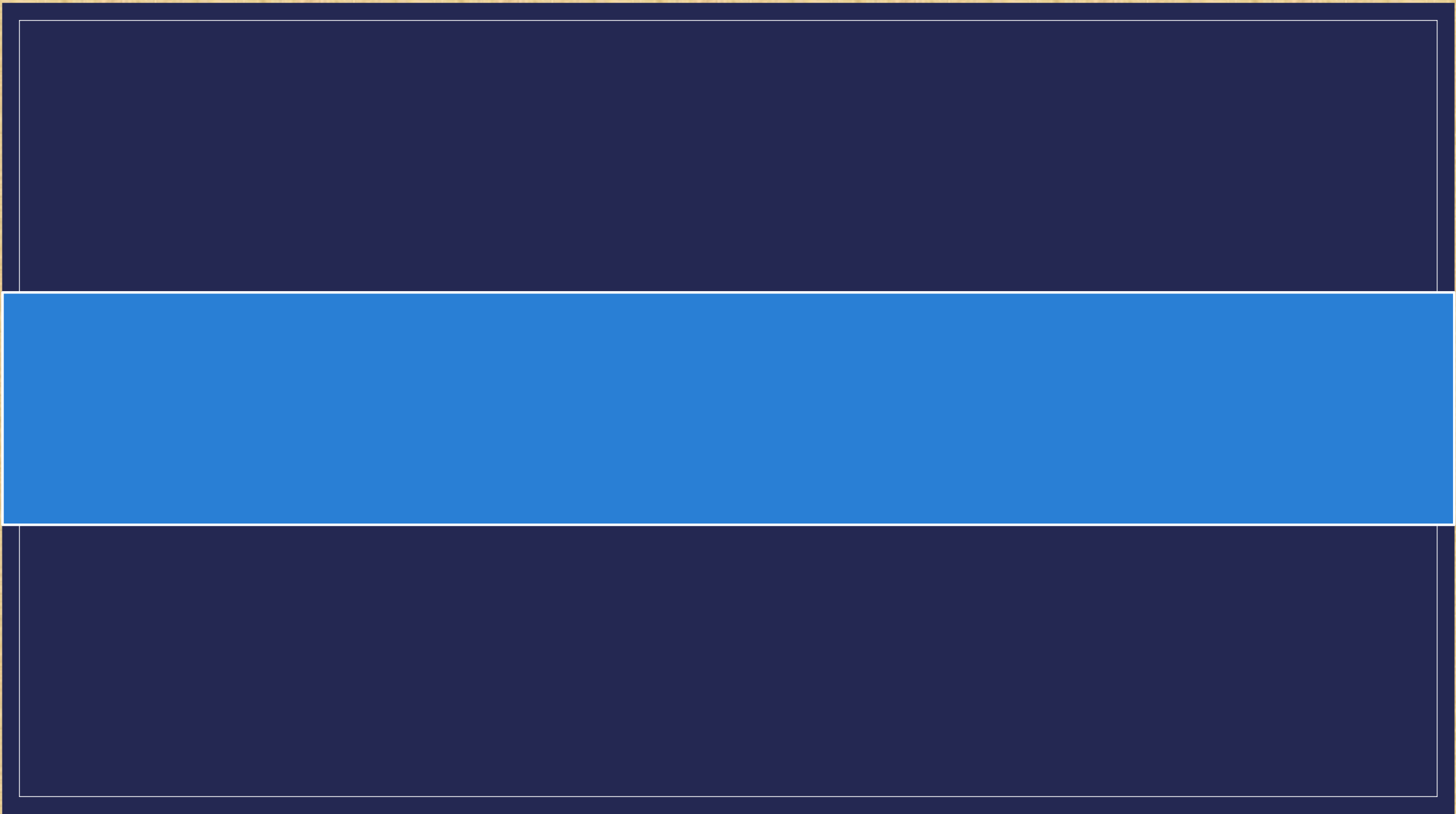
