




O'God, to you alone we lift our souls; in you alone we place our trust; for you alone we wait all day long. For you are the God of our salvation, abounding in

People: He is Emmanuel, the promised of the ages.




# Lighting the Candle of Hope

O come, thou root of Jesse's tree, an ensign of thy people be; before thee rulers silent fall; all peoples on thy mercy call










continued to sin against them, you were angry. How then can we be saved? <sup>6</sup> All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like


filthy rags; we all shrivel up like a leaf, and like the wind our sins sweep us away.


There's a song in the air! There's a star in the sky! There's a mother's deep prayer and a baby's low cry!
