My love for music is nearly equal to my love for books. I've always had eclectic musical taste. I listen to everything from hip-hop, R&B, classical, Latin fusion, movie and Broadway musical soundtracks, and some country.

My father was a really complicated person, but my love of music stems from him. As a kid, most of my allowances were spent at the local record store. Music has always been an important means of expression for me personally and for Black people culturally.

That's why music shows up in nearly every story I write, playing in the background or one character is teaching the other how to dance. Marvin Gaye, LTD, or some other iconic Black artist is playing while the love interests get to know each other as they sway on the dance floor.

My Love & Music Suite series, which follows the career and romantic adventures of a school of the arts alumni, gave me the opportunity to marry my love of music and literature. It's been fun creating these characters and learning more about what goes on behind the scenes in the music industry.


Sean crafts stories that blend sweetness with a touch of spice, exploring the complexities of love, relationships, and family drama.







Quiana Nicole

Born and raised in Menlo Park, California, Quiana Nicole discovered her desire for writing in fourth grade where she started writing poetry and short stories. It wasn't until much later that her passion for writing grew from a hobby into therapy.

In 2014, Quiana wrote her first novel 'Dirty Lil' Secrets'. She has since penned several collaborations as well, you can find all of her titles on Amazon or Barnes & Noble. In 2017, Quiana started her own company and is now the President and CEO of Major Key Publishing, a black-owned publishing company that is empowering and equipping black authors to produce worldchanging books.

When asked about the impact of Black Music on her work as an author Quiana says:

Black music—from spirituals to jazz, blues to hip-hop—was never just about sound. It was survival. It was code. It was community. As an author, I see Black music as literature in motion. The beats, the rhymes, the refrains—those are the chapters of struggle, defiance, and hope.

For me, Black music isn't background noise—it's bloodline. It's memory. It's the sound of who we are, who we've been, and who we keep becoming.

When I write, I don't just hear my own voice—I hear the hum of spirituals sung by people who had nothing but still created beauty. I hear the sharp truth of Nina Simone and the raw vulnerability of Donny Hathaway. I hear Lauryn Hill's honesty, Kendrick Lamar's questions, and the way Jay-Z turned pain into power. That's not just music. That's blueprint.

Artists like Kendrick document reality: political, social, spiritual. As a writer, that teaches me to be unflinching. To write what's real, even when it's uncomfortable. To honor truth over trend - ALWAYS.


Black music is endlessly inventive. It reminds me that our stories can't-and shouldn't-fit into anyone else's box.

There's a certain courage in Black music. A refusal to be erased. That's the spirit I try to bring to my writing. I want my work to echo with the same boldness, the same truth-telling, the same soul. Even if nobody claps, even if nobody "gets it" at first-just like some of our greatest artists-I'm still going to tell the story.

Because our music didn't just shape me. It raised me. And now, through my words, I try to give something back.




When asked about the impact of Black Music on his work as an author Thaddeus says:
