Instructions and Explanations for Registration

Pre-registration is of much value to the Dean's planning and preparation for that week of camp. You are encouraged to send your registration in early. **Families sending more than one child may deduct \$10.00 for the second or third child attending a full week camp. New for 2025, if you register by camp kickoff your camper will receive a FREE OVCA Camp t-shirt with the camp theme. T-shirts may be purchased after early registration for a fee of \$15*

Congregations that pay the entire amount of camp fees for their camp participants need not send a deposit with the registration. If the local congregation is not paying the fee, a \$50.00 deposit should be included with the registration.

PRE-REGISTRATION: ****Please do not send cash**** Checks and money orders are acceptable. Cash will be accepted at the camp during that weeks' registration. We do also accept PayPal on our website at ovcacadcamp.org.

Your child should be registered as to the grade of school they will be entering in the fall of 2024.
For example: A person entering the 8th grade in August/September 2024 would register for Junior High week.

SNACKS & MISSION OFFERINGS:

Canteen (snack shack) money is included in the camp fees. No money will be needed for snacks.

There will be an offering taken every day for the support of a Mission project selected for the week. You are encouraged to financially support that project. Sending cash with your camper is acceptable for this.

A written authorization from the parent stating when a camper is leaving the camp during a camp day. We will need to know when the camper leaves, how often and who will be transporting the child, this will need to be provided to the Dean on the first day of camp.
IT IS IMPORTANT FOR THE PARENT(S) TO UNDERSTAND THAT A CAMPER WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE CAMP WITHOUT A WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE PARENT/GUARDIAN AND THAT AUTHORIZATION MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE CAMPADMINISTRATOR OR THE DEAN AT THE CAMP. Ohio Valley Christian Assembly insurance only assists medical injuries occurring during the duration of the OVCA program. Individual insurance coverage will be primarily responsible for extended coverage and OVCA will be limited secondary coverage only.

What should I bring to Camp?

- ☐ Bible, notepad, pen / pencil
- ☐ Twin sized bedding and blanket or sleeping bag, and pillow
- ☐ Wash cloth or loofah for showering
- ☐ Toiletries such as shampoo, soap, body wash, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.
- ☐ Camp appropriate bathing suit and towel
- ☐ Weather appropriate clothing for the week
- ☐ Several pairs of shoes for a variety of both indoor and outdoor activities
- ☐ Old clothes for playing messy games
- ☐ Sweatshirt or light jacket for cool evenings
- ☐ Flip flops or shower shoes for showering
- ☐ Liability / Registration form
- ☐ Balance of money owed for the week
- ☐ Money for the camp mission
- ☐ Any medications needed for the week (turn in to camp nurse upon arrival)

What Not to bring to Camp?

- ✗ Alcohol, drugs, vapes, or tobacco of any kind
- ✗ Inappropriate or offensive clothing (you may be asked to change at the discretion of dean / staff)
- ✗ Weapons or knives
- ✗ No two-piece swimwear is permitted (unless covered by outer layer)
- ✗ Tube tops and spaghetti straps are not permitted, shorts must be of reasonable length and coverage
- ✗ Any expensive electronics that could get lost or damaged during the week

Camp Cell Phone Policy

We understand the need for families to rely on cell phones for crucial communication. With that in mind we allow for cell phones to be used **ONLY** within the following guidelines:

- Cell phones are brought out **ONLY** at times deemed acceptable and not during worship, teaching, or small group times.
- Cell phone usage is **limited** and does not become a distraction for the camper or others. Our goal is to connect with God and one another this week, and that's difficult if we are constantly on our phones
- Camp photos are encouraged and appreciated. Your dean may even encourage photography of certain events, but please be aware that there may be campers whose images should not appear on social media for privacy / safety reasons. For that reason please consult with the dean and staff before posting any pictures of other campers.
- Cell phone usage should not be abusive to other campers. Taking inappropriate / abusive photos, or otherwise using phones to degrade others is considered cyber-bullying and is a reason for immediate dismissal from camp. Before taking a photo or posting about another student ask yourself "does this paint this person, the camp, and myself in a positive light?"
- Communication with family at home can cause homesickness and should be limited (especially for younger campers). Before parents decide to pick a camper up early, a conversation should be had with the camp dean prior to arriving at camp to get the student. Please do not show up to pick up camper without first contacting the dean.
