HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Come to the library on or after **June 13th** to pick up your Summer Reading log.
- Pick up a free book to keep when you sign up for Summer Reading!
- In your tracker sheet, log each day that you read for at least 15 minutes.
- After completing 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, or 80 days of reading, you can pick a small prize and be entered into a drawing for a larger prize.
- Reading ends **August 31st**. The drawing will be **September 8th**.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

If you are an Ecorse library card holder, you can participate. Come to the library with photo ID and sign up for a card if you don't have one already. Open to all ages.
