 **Law of Mechanical Repair** - After your hands become coated with grease, your nose will begin to itch and you'll have to pee.


 **Law of Gravity** - Any tool, nut, bolt, screw, when dropped, will roll to the least accessible corner.

 **Law of Random Numbers** - If you dial a wrong number, you never get a busy signal and someone always answers.


 **Variation Law** - If you change lines (or traffic lanes), the one you were in will always move faster than the one you are in now (this works every time).


 **Law of the Bath** - When the body is fully immersed in water, Jim McNeil will always call.


 **Law of Close Encounters** - The probability of meeting someone you know increases dramatically when you are with someone you don't want to be seen with.


 **Law of the Result** - When you try to prove to someone that something on your car won't work, it will.


 **Law of Biomechanics** - When working on a carburetor, the severity of the itch is inversely proportional to the reach.

 **Murphy's Law of Lockers** - If there are only 2 people in a locker room, they will have adjacent lockers.



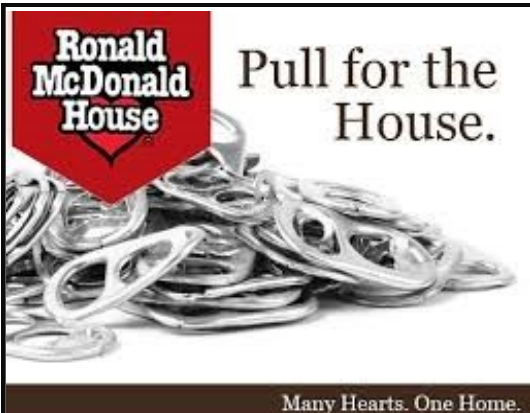
