## APPLE JACK FESTIVAL

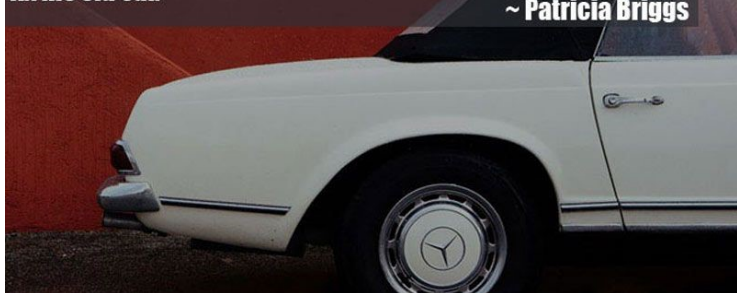
