The December <u>General</u> Meeting will be December 16th, also via computer. Results of the election will be revealed at this meeting



So, the question now becomes: How can your spouse NOT afford to become a Member for only \$4?



I told her it was chicken. She asked me why, so I told her it was because you could make them into fried chicken.


She sent me back to the principal's office. He laughed and told me not to do it again.

Have you ever had Deja Vu? Have you ever had Deja Vu??


If we quit voting will they all go away?
