
July 25th Jack Takemoto is having an auction. Location 1 ½ miles east of the Eagle Raceway.



I must say, these flame paint jobs are getting more and more realistic.




REBELS JOKE OF THE MONTH

So, will there be more of these next month? The answer is "Yes." (but sadly, they don't get any better!)

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
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
