April 2020 Executive Meeting (via computer)

VP Jack called the meeting to order at 7pm. Jack suggested the minutes from this meeting be used for the newsletter since there will be no general meeting in April. Margaret said she would get them sent to Gary Willey so he can also put them on the website. If we were able to have an Executive

Board Meeting in May it will be at Firehouse Subs at East Park. That date would be May 12<sup>th</sup>. The May General Meeting date is scheduled for May 27<sup>th</sup>, and it will be determined later if it is possible to have the Meeting and the location. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the Vice President report. Margaret did say that all performances at Pinewood Bowl have been canceled for the summer. She wondered if the city was also going to cancel other activities in the park. Jim McNeil said he would check with the city parks department as to the status of our Car Show. Mark Walker said Spring SCCA (cone races) have been moved to August 19<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup>. That is two weeks before nationals. Jim said he has calendars and Car Council books. He will pass them out at the first meeting that we are able to have. The Berean Church car show has been canceled so Tom Dingwell is using all his shares from the swap meet for calendars for the Rebel's. Jim said he had not heard an update on the Sower's Club car show. Doug Weber said he and Don will be out collecting door prizes as soon as it is safe to be out and about. Johnny Nunn received an award at World of Wheels for club display. A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the Coordinator's report.

Steve Anderson gave the Treasurer's report. Steve reported that income for the month was from Car Show entries, Membership renewals and Car Show Sponsorship. Expenses for the month were from advertising (car council book) and web hosting. A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the treasurer's report.



So, will there be more of these next month? The answer is "Yes." (but sadly, they don't get any better!)





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

















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
