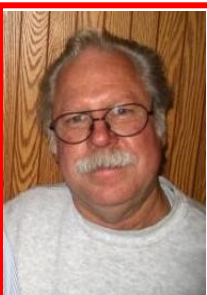

World of Wheels is still planning on having their event in Omaha. If we do not have enough members taking cars to Omaha, we will not be supporting for the college team to have their cars there either.

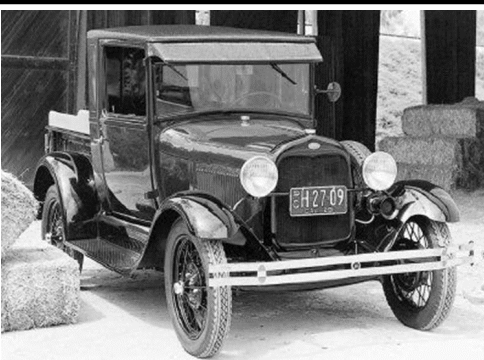
The March 17th **ENWI Car Council** will meet at the **Pizza Ranch** at 7:30 and distribute new books to all the car clubs.
