Dear Crafter,

On behalf of the Mountain Empire Men's Club (MEMC), I'm pleased to announce our **49th** Annual Pine Valley Day's celebration will be held on July 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, however only the 27<sup>th</sup> is the Country Fair for all Crafters. **ALL** of the action, less the parade, will be in the Pine Valley County Park, with entrance at the North end of Pine Valley Road. Booths will be limited to the first **75** applications received with the necessary paperwork and a \$75 paid entrance fee (check made out to MEMC). **Deadline is July 1st.** Applications after July 1st (if space is available) will be \$100 paid by July 22nd. Again this year will be a raffle drawing for Craft prizes donated by the crafters. A \$10 discount will be given to the entrance fee if a craft prize is donated. All proceeds from the raffle will go to the Mountain Empire Men's Club scholarship fund (see vendor form for more details).

**Necessary paperwork:**

In addition to the \$75 fee include a copy of your Seller's Permit (indicate what you plan to sell.) A free seller's permit can be obtained from the CA State Board of Equalization.

**Note:**

Expect a confirmation e-mail from me (once your application has been accepted) which will include instructions on site location and set-up.

**Location:**

Pine Valley is approximately 45 miles east of San Diego and just off Interstate 8, Exit 45. Booths, setup services or electricity, are not provided. Space is limited to 12' x 12' area. Booths can be setup Friday afternoon but no security is provided. You are advised to plan your space setup based on the following events:

A great Deep Pit BBQ Friday night (5 - 8 PM), followed at 8 PM with dancing to live music.

Saturday:

The parade down old Hwy 80 starts at 9 AM on Saturday the 27<sup>th</sup> (if you're not at your site **before** 9 AM plan on a 1 ½ hour delay of reaching your site).

Breakfast at the Pine Valley Improvement Club clubhouse on Saturday 7-9 and 10-11 AM  
Vender Fair, Horse-shoe tournament, Rock Climb, Kiddie Rides, 11 AM – 5 PM in the park  
Music in the Park from 11:00 AM to 5 PM
