

Dear Crafter,

On behalf of the MEMC, I'm pleased to announce our **54th** Annual Pine Valley Days celebration will be held on July 26th and 28th, however only the 27th is the Country Fair for all Crafters. **ALL** of the action, less the parade, will be in the Pine Valley County Park, with entrance at the North end of Pine Valley Road. Booths will be limited to the first **75** applications received with the necessary paperwork and a \$65 paid entrance fee (check made out to MEMC). **Deadline is July 1st.** Applications after July 1st (if space is available) will be \$90 paid by July 17th. We will not be accepting any applications after July 17th. There will be no day of walk ons.

We will not have a raffle this year.

Necessary paperwork:

In addition to the \$65 fee include a copy of your Seller's Permit (indicate what you plan to sell.) A free seller's permit can be obtained from the CA State Board of Equalization.

Note:

Expect a confirmation e-mail from me (once your application has been accepted) which will include instructions on site location and set-up.

Location:

Pine Valley is approximately 45 miles east of San Diego and just off Interstate 8, Exit 45. Booths, setup services or electricity, are not provided. Space is limited to 12' x 12' area. Booths can be setup Friday afternoon but no security is provided. You are advised to plan your space setup based on the following events:

A great Deep Pit BBQ Friday night (5 - 8 PM), followed at 8 PM with dancing to live music.

Saturday:

The parade down old Hwy 80 starts at 9 AM on Saturday the 29th (if you're not at your site **before** 9 AM plan on a 1 ½ hour delay of reaching your site).

Sausage burrito breakfast at the Pine Valley Improvement Club clubhouse on Saturday 7-9 and 10-11 AM
Horse-shoe tournament, Kiddie Rides, 11 AM – 4 PM in the park
Music in the Park from 11:00 AM to 4 PM
