Door Access:

- The cabin front door has a 4-digit code for access to cabin. This code will be sent to you in a separate email prior to your arrival to the cabin. Enter code and turn knob to the right to unlock door. To lock, press the "Schlage" button at the top center of keypad and turn knob to the left to lock door.

(DO NOT LOCK THE BOTTOM LEVER FROM INSIDE THE CABIN, YOU DO NOT HAVE A KEY)

KITCHEN:

- Please take extra care to not place hot items directly on the countertops. Hot pads are available for your convenience.
- Please feel free to reposition the mobile kitchen island anywhere that is convenient for your party.
- The trash can is located underneath the open pantry shelving inside a concealed door. If you need to remove a full bag of trash, once the door is open, step on the wooden release lever on the floor to open the door even wider for easy access to the full bag. Extra trash bags are located underneath the kitchen sink and inside the receptacle underneath the bag in use.
- A step stool is located to the left of the trash can door.
- A fire extinguisher is located inside the open pantry shelves.
- Appliances available include refrigerator, electric stove, microwave, dishwasher, toaster and Keurig coffee maker.
- Cabin is fully furnished with dishes, utensils, and pots and pans for cooking.

- You must provide your own food, spices for cooking, drinks, condiments, etc...
- Several pods of coffee will be supplied to get you through the first day.

LIVING/DINING AREA:

- Please take extra care to not place hot items directly on the dining table. Place mats and hot pads are available for your convenience.
- Remote controls for the A/C, ceiling fans and TV/DVR are conveniently mounted on the wall to the right of the door. Instructions for how to operate the A/C will be in the welcome book on the dining room table. Please read before making change to HVAC. This a Mini Split Heat Pump System and operates differently than your systems at home.
- Bedding for the queen size murphy bed and queen size sofa bed are located in the open shelving in each of the bedrooms.
- Queen/King size fleece blankets for the murphy bed and sofa bed are located on the quilt rack in the living room. There are also two lap blankets (soft fluffy white one's) available for your use.
- Pillows are located in the storage area underneath the banquette seating area around the dining table.
- Feel free to move the rocking chair as needed to use the murphy bed or the sofa fold out bed.
- You will also find in the storage area underneath the banquette seating regular playing cards, Uno cards, dominos, as well as the WIFI router. WIFI is free for guests.

- Feel free to use your favorite streaming service on the SMART TV. Also provided is a DVD with HDMI cable to play your favorite guest supplied movies. (Don't forget to close your steaming service before you leave the cabin.)

BEDROOMS:

- Remote controls for the A/C are conveniently located to the right of the light switch.
- Extra king size linens as well as queen size linens for the murphy bed and sofa bed are located in the bedroom open shelving and are labeled accordingly.
- Extra luggage racks for guests sleeping in the living room are located in the bottom section of the bedroom open shelving.
- Vacuum cleaner, dust mop and regular mop are located inside the storage closet behind the master bedroom door.

BATHROOMS:

- Hairdryers are provided for your convenience.
- PLEASE do not use towels and wash cloths to clean your ATV's and UTV's.
- Ladies, instead of white towels, PLEASE use provided wipes or black towels for makeup removal.
- Do not dispose of feminine products, wipes or paper towel in the toilets – Flushing feminine products will damage the septic tank.

ROCKING CHAIRS:

- Please do not remove rocking chairs from the porch or from inside the cabin.

TRASH:

- There is an outside trash receptacle located at the front edge of the driveway.

PARKING:

- Please do not block the road in front of the cabin.
- Use only the gravel driveways for parking.

GRILL:

- A charcoal grill for outdoor grilling is provided. You must provide your own charcoal and lighter fluid. Lighters can be found in the cabin for your use on the grille and fire pit.
- Please ensure fires are extinguished before retiring for the night.
- Please dump grille ashes into the fire pit before checking out of the cabin.

FIREPIT AND PICNIC TABLE:

- A large fire pit is provided with bench seating. There is also a nice wooden picnic table. Some firewood may be available, but you may be required to gather your own or bring your own from home. Please DO NOT cut down any trees for firewood. There is an abundance of fallen trees and limbs that can be gathered and used for firewood.
- Please ensure fires are extinguished before retiring for the night. This is a **LAW**, please do not leave open fires unattended. During summer months a burn ban may be in effect, check with local authorities before building camp fires.

LAUNDRY:

- NOTE: We have a laundry room/building for your convenience. Several pods of laundry detergent will be supplied for your use. You must supply your own if more is needed.
- The access code for the laundry will be sent along with the cabin code.
- You can also use this room as lockable storage while you are out riding in the forest.
- The door inside the laundry is restricted and is not accessible for your use.

PRIOR TO YOUR DEPARTURE:

- Please do not leave dirty dishes in the sink. Dirty dishes can be placed in the dishwasher and the dishwasher started prior to your departure. Several pods of dishwashing detergent will be provided.
- Place all clean dishes back in their designated areas.
- Place all dirty towels in a pile on the bathroom floor or in the provided laundry hamper.
- Place all remote controls in their designated mounts in the living/dining area as well as the bedrooms.
- Place all thermostats on 75 degrees for a/c mode or 68 degrees for heat mode prior to your departure.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT:** NO SMOKING inside the cabin. Feel free to smoke outside but PLEASE take care not to throw your butts on the ground. NOTE: Smoking inside cabin **will** result in a very **large cleaning and deodorizing** charge to your credit card on file.
- **PLEASE NOTE** - ALL properties (and driveways) bordering and nearby our driveway and property on County Road 402 and 42 are indeed privately owned and the owners do not welcome pleasure riding nor trespassing of any kind on to their properties. Please be respectful of their properties.
- **Bethesda Lake is privately owned and operated as part of the Bethesda Lake Cabins. The lake and surrounding areas are not public use. You will be immediately asked to leave if you are not a guest of Bethesda Lake Cabins.**
- **No pets are allowed.** Pet boarding is available locally.

- Mobile phone service for ATT & Verizon others will be roaming. Reception is best outside the cabin.
- AMRock Cabin has a pin on Google Maps - you can route to your location by using Google Maps and specifically finding "AMRock Cabin". Routing to the physical address of 125 Polk Rd 402 rather than AMRock Cabin does not always route properly.
- There are two different primary routes into the property. One of the two routes is mostly paved. The west end of county road 42 is NOT paved. The paved route is referred to as the "Bethesda Road Access (aka – County Road 44)"
 - "Bethesda Road Access" - Turn south off of Highway 71 on the southern side of Mena (immediately next to "Country Express" gas station). Travel 2.8 miles down Bethesda Road (aka County Road 44) where you will turn right on to County Road 42. After you turn on County Road 42, travel ¼ mile. Turn left on to County Road 402 (Gravel Road). Go approximately 100 yards and turn left into the first driveway on the left. Welcome to Rock Creek Cabin.
- Wolf Pen Gap access –There are two different ways to access wolf pen gap. You can drive in or trailer in.
- We suggest that you use the "Maprika" app for Android or Iphone. Once app is downloaded search for the "2022 Wolfpen-OMTAC" map. Drop a pin at the cabin location should be indicated by a blue arrowhead as your present location. The app will then track your location as you move around the forest.

We are convenient:

What's great about our cabin location is you can take a beautiful, scenic 30-40 minute legal ride on dirt back roads to the west or south trail head (no need to trailer your ATV). You can turn left out of Rock Creek Cabin on to County Road 402. Follow it several miles to the Shady community. You WILL, however need a map if you are not familiar with these area roads. If you choose to trailer in, turn right out of the Rock Creek Cabin onto County Road 402, turn right (east) on to county road 42. Go to County Road 44 and turn right. Travel on County Road 44 for less than a mile and turn right on Highway 375 East. Travel just 4 miles on Highway 375 East and the West Trail Head will be located on your left. For your safety, please ride cautiously on the state highway. Riding on the public roads outside of the city limits is legal in Arkansas as long as you are traveling only from one trail head to another or from your cabin directly to the trail head.
