1. *Don't go unless you plan to stay.* Pastors of past generations, like Calvin and Edwards, considered a call to a church similar to a marriage. Pastors today need to learn from those examples in order to remain faithful and loyal to the church God called them to. Yes, there will be trials in any church, but if a pastor is committed to stay when they arrive, it will give them a heart to endure.

2. *Be patient.* Patience with people may be the most important lesson a pastor can ever learn. This process takes time, and it only comes from trusting the Holy Spirit's power.

3. *Be thankful and humble.* Both of these adjectives are mandatory for every pastor. Our church may not be as big or as rich as a church down the road, but it helps to remember that, no matter where we are planted, we are unworthy of what we've been given.

4. *Trust the Word to do its work.* People today need divine answers, however, instead of getting theologically sound sermons, they may be offered human artificial substitutes that won't help. A bible-based sermon will satisfy a hungry heart, and also increase the appetite for more. God's Word provides deep treasures and fresh truths that no amount of years will exhaust.

So today, I want to again say, "Thank you" to this church family, as well as thank the Lord for His call. It is truly a privilege to call FBC of Sedan my church home. God bless you all!
