When Japanese forces forced General Douglas MacArthur out of the Philippines during WWII, he promised, “I will return.” It was during the same war that John Peterson, a US Army Air Force pilot, flew missions over SE Asia. 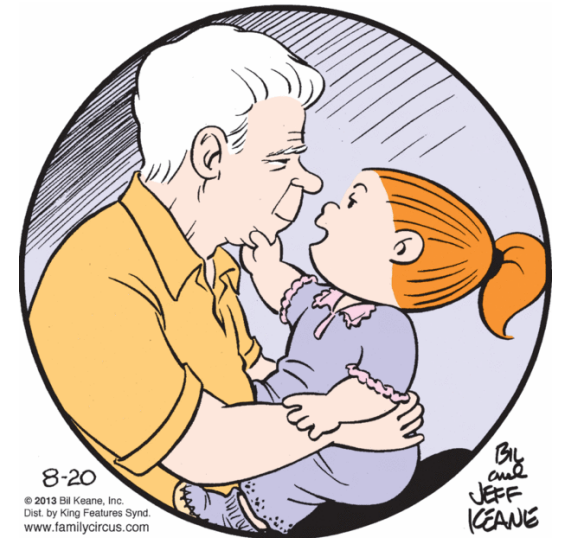
