Pastor's Pen:

Can you imagine what David the shepherd boy felt when he was suddenly called to meet the prophet Samuel? What was he thinking when Samuel poured the oil over his head and announced that he would be the next king of Israel? Then, he went back to his flock of sheep, and everything went back to normal.

David was the youngest of eight brothers, all sons of Jesse. He started his life shepherding sheep. Nevertheless, he was the one chosen by God to eventually tend God's precious sheep, the children of Israel.

Shepherding is one of the oldest and least respected occupations, but God prepared David for his role as king – not in a palace – but in pastures. It was David's life as a shepherd that prepared him for his life as a king. Much of what he learned leading sheep he applied as a leader of men.

Spending time wandering through the hills and valleys, as David faithfully cared for his father's flocks, he surely came to know and obey the Lord. There, David was content as he was being taught how to become the king of Israel. All too often we Christians do not recognize that God puts us in various jobs and occupations for His purpose.

Ephesians 6:5-8 speaks about us envisioning that behind every employer stands the Lord Jesus Christ. He sees everything we do, and He appreciates it. His rewards will result, regardless of the type of work we do. Even the most menial jobs are a labor of love and worship for Christ. He sees and appreciates what we do. If we will accept that truth, it forever changes our attitude, our outlook, and our view of work.

Work is God's gift. It is through our work we can demonstrate our love for God. When we work, we obey two of His commandments: to love Him - by obeying, and to love our neighbor - by serving. We bring glory to Him by our work. That's why work matters!
