

Fort Hays State University (FHSU) Criminal Justice Program & University Police facilitate the Central Region Training Center of the National De-escalation Training Center. In addition, Dr. Tamara Lynn serves as NDTC **Executive Council President and coordinates with** regions across the U.S. to facilitate training to agencies from other areas. Dr. Morgan Steele serves as NDTC National Research Coordinator and guides data collection and analysis across the national network. FHSU has received \$3.55 million in grant funding including \$2.05 from Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) and \$1.50 from Byrne Community Project Development - to deliver the training at little to no cost to agencies. Wayne State University (Great Lakes Region) and University of New Haven (Eastern Region) have also received federal funding through the COPS Office to support operations.

# FEDERALLY FUNDED TRAINING AT LITTLE TO NO COST TO AGENCIES US DEPT OF JUSTICE RECOMMENDED DE-ESCALATION TRAINING

FHSU facilitates NDTC's four training modalities, including an 8-hour De-escalation Fundamentals (online at trainee pace or in-person), 16-hour De-escalation: Principles & Practice, and a 32-hour train-the-trainer program. Due to FHSU's \$3.55 million federal grant funding, all training modalities can be provided at little to no cost to agencies.

NDTC training is approved by the Office of Community-Oriented Policing Services (COPS) and certified by the International Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and Training (IADLEST).

#### Level 1-Procedural Justice

- Traditional de-escalation that conveys respect, permits venting, and active listening.
- Approaches all individuals the same.

#### Level 2 - Crisis Intervention

- Identifies those individuals experiencing a physical or mental health crisis or engaged in substance use or abuse.
- Other methods of de-escalation are required.

#### Level 3 - Personality Modeling

- Augments levels 1 and 2 with rapid personality identification to stabilize and de-escalate subjects based on personality.
- Methods vary based on an individual's emotional state and needs.
- De-escalate more efficiently and safely.
