- V. Treasurer Update given by Beth Posocco Full Treasurer's Report
  - Balance in checking account as of May is \$9,978.58
  - Receivables since last reporting period include a \$485 donation, \$8 on-the-spot dance ticket sales, and \$4,335 from the Spring book fair
  - Disbursements since last reporting period include \$565 for Teacher Appreciation Week and \$634 reimbursement for dance concessions.
  - Anticipated disbursements include additional dance reimbursements (~\$300),
    Teacher Appreciation Week (~\$700), Field day snow cones (~\$1,100), chalk the walk, yearbook poster, and insurance policy.
