Why Travel with your FRC Team?



- Make life-long memories
- Compete with new teams
- New experiences beyond your hometown
- Bond as a team

It's FUN!!!

Hotels



- Free HOT Breakfast
 - *Continental breakfast isn't as filling*
- Students per room
 - *3-5 per room (2 beds)*
 - *5-7 for a suite*
 - *Some are going to sleep on the floor!*
- Look for deals
 - *Ex: Choice Hotels - points add up to free nights*
- Know District rules on chaperones
- Interior hallways preferred for safety
- Hotel location matters
 - *Near venue is great, but is it safe?*

Road Trips



- Break up long drives
 - *Ex: leave after school and drive part way*
- Bring school work
- Get minibus certified
 - Saves on charter or rental costs
 - Avg FRC team fits in two minibuses
- Bring games
- Bring snacks
 - *Ask parents to donate*
- Gas/food stops take longer with a group

Flights



- **All students need a state ID!**
- Send luggage with robot/pit if possible
 - *Students carry backpack only*
- Require matching “travel shirts” or uniforms
- Count students as they board
- Write up an announcement for flight crew introducing your team
- Group rates
- Direct flights (no plane changes)
- Pass out boarding passes at security

Safety



- **Set clear expectations for behavior**
- Hold Team meetings in a public space
 - *Ex: lobby or conference room*
 - *No guys in girls rooms or vise versa*
 - *No mentors in student rooms or vise versa*
- Bed checks at set time
 - *No one leaves after that time*
 - *Minimum two students per room*
- Pool
 - *No swimming without an adult present*
 - *Shorts and t-shirts suggested*
- Buddy system ALWAYS
- **DRINK LOTS OF WATER** (*especially in Flagstaff*)
- Follow district policies on chaperones
 - *Ex: RoboProm or overnight trips*

Packing List - Team



- Robot
- Spare Parts/Batteries
- Toolbox
- Pit Display
- Swag
- Spirit stuff (ex: *signs*)
- Judging materials & handouts
- Scouting system
- Programming computer/Driver Station
- Team Meals
 - Coolers
 - Gas grill/smoker
 - Snacks
 - Drinks

Packing List - Students



- Team Uniform
 - *Send a list for each day, including travel days*
- Toiletries
- Pillow + blanket for bus
- Sleeping bag (*give number of students/room*)
- Scouting (ex: iPad or pen/paper)
- Homework
- Phone & charger
- Team branded sweatshirt, hoodie, etc
- Water bottle
- **Money for meals on the road**
 - Ex: Dinner Sat or travel lunches
- Snacks (*cheapest if bought NOT at a gas station*)

Team Cost vs Student Cost



- **STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING:**
 - Travel expenses
 - Hotel, meals, activities, flights
 - Meals on travel days
 - Uniform
 - Travel shirt (yellow)
 - Team shirts/polos/sweatshirts, fleece
 - Shorts/skirts/hats/socks/belts, etc
 - Tax Credit donations & fundraisers
- **SPONSORS & TAX CREDIT DONATIONS COVER:**
 - Robot parts
 - Regional & Championship Entry Fees
 - Coach/mentor hotels
 - Competition Expenses
 - Printing, swag
 - Unexpected (*ex: trailer repair*)

Example Itinerary & Budget - PHX Regional 2024



ITINERARY

- Thurs 5 AM Meet at school; travel to regional to arrive when pits open
- Fri All day - Regional
- Sat All day - Regional; depart after awards
- Sat ~9:00 PM Arrive at school

COST - 16 students

- 2 nights in a hotel: \$800 (4 student rooms)
- Lunches, 3 days: \$550
- Dinners, 2 nights: \$500
 - *Meals were all take out - no "tailgating"*
- Other: \$150 (ex: parking, activities)
- TOTAL COST: \$2000
- COST PER STUDENT: \$120

Example Itinerary & Budget - Utah Regional 2024



ITINERARY

- Tue: Meet after school; drive to Panguich, UT
- Wed: Bryce Canyon; Drive to SLC; load in
- Thurs: Utah Regional
- Fri: Utah Regional
- Sat: Utah Regional; dinner on the road; drive to hotel south of SLC
- Sun: Drive home; ~3:00 PM Arrive at school

COST - 17 students

- 5 nights in a hotel: \$4000 (includes adults)
- Meals (Wed-Sat, lunch & dinner): \$500
 - *All meals tailgate style - no take out*
- Other: \$50 (ex: parking, activities)
- TOTAL COST: \$4550; COST/STUDENT: \$200



Beyond the Competition

- National Parks & Monuments
 - *National Parks allow school groups to visit for FREE*
 - *Apply for a fee waiver at least one month in advance*
- Science Centers, Art Museums, Aquariums
- State/City Parks
- Hiking Trails
- City Centers & Local Attractions
 - *ex: Street Art experience in Miami*
- Many attractions offer school discounts



Flagstaff Fun!

- National Parks & National Monuments
 - Grand Canyon
 - Sunset Crater/Wupatki/Walnut Canyon
 - *Free with a school field trip waiver!*
- Meteor Crater
- Flagstaff Snow Park
 - *Snow play and tubing; day and night sessions*
- Sedona
- Lowell Observatory
 - *Where Pluto was discovered!*
 - *NEW astronomy discovery center*
- Flag Laser Tag
- Flagstaff Urban Trail & Park System - *free!*

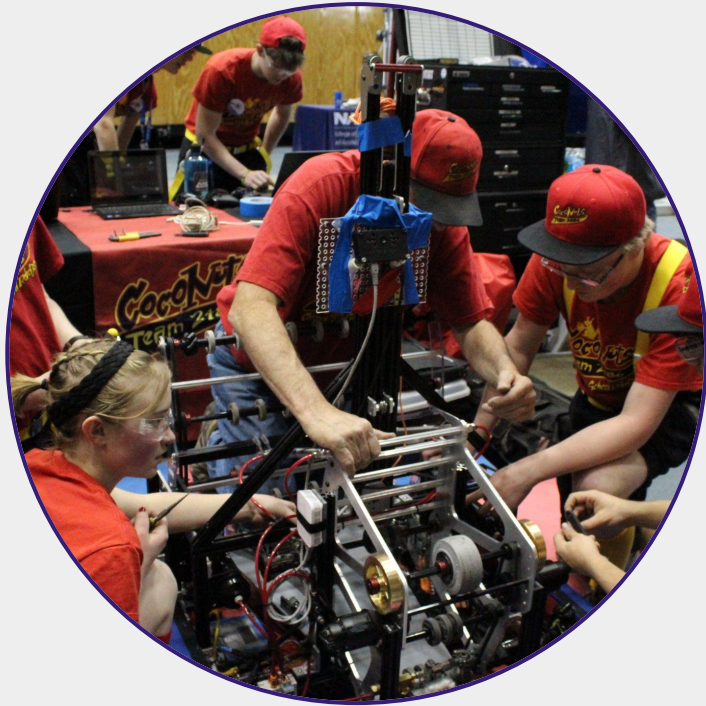


Is it going to SNOW?!?
