

Class H-Photography

Entries due Monday, August 3rd, 2020 from 9am - 5pm with judging to begin at entry closing.

Open Class Photography is open to all non-professional and professional artists from high school age and beyond and will be judged in three lots - High School Student, Adult and Professional. The final decision on the amateur status of an entrant will be solely the responsibility of the superintendent.

(4-H, Campfire and other organized youth group members involved in the photography as a project will not be eligible to enter this class.)

Exhibitors are limited to a maximum of 5 entries.

Use of captions or titles is encouraged. Each entry must be matted or mounted. Minimum print size 5"x 7" with no maximum size. Entries must have been taken within the last two years and not previously shown at this fair. Prints with frames welcomed if equipped with wire hangers ready for hanging. No Exceptions!

Judging criteria included the following: A) Composition; B) Lines; C) Rhythm; D) Tonalities; E) Lighting; F) Color; G) Tone; H) Individuality; I) Mood; J) Texture; K) Contrast; L) Simplicity; M) Depth.

Additional non-judged photos may be displayed in a separate section for general entertainment, limit 5.

A total of \$125.00 will be allotted to this division to be divided as the show warrants, maximum purple ribbon award \$2.00, maximum blue-ribbon award \$1.50.

Winners must pick up premium money on Sunday, August 9th, 2020 from 10am – 12pm, when exhibits are released.

\$25.00 given to an outstanding exhibitor in each class. Award given based on effort and quality to promote our open class
