Specific objective:

To promote livelihoods options among women of villages with Skill Development

The event:

Event: The BEAUTY PARLOUR TRAINING was organized at DHROL after proper need assessment and on the specific request of the local women. They have access to raw material and local demand also for backward and forward linkages for running the beauty parlour business or getting the job after the training.



BEAUTY PARLOUR work is easily manageable from home while doing other domestic work. Women in village normally have free times during the afternoon so the training was organized during those hours for maximum participation from the village.

Training Schedule:

The training was organized between 7th February to 28th March 2018 for 20 days as per the trainers' suggestion. She had prepared a specialized curriculum and module for each day. Accordingly various types of beauty tips and Make Ups were demonstrated during the training sessions by all the participants. Mainly Bridal make is in demand so every participant learned it quite passionately.



The participation:

We had a wonderful participation from the village. 20 women participated and successfully completed the training. The community and village leaders and elected members motivated the participants by visiting the training centre during the course of training. This also provided indirect monitoring to the centre and ensured the quality output.



Certificate distribution:

CAIRN INDIA top officials Mr. Avinash raval from Viramgam Terminal remained present and distributed the certificates to the candidates and motivated them towards starting own small business on the basis of the learning during the training.



The Linkages and Network:

CEDRA has ensured the forward and backward linkages for raw materials. Official from Godrej and Saath was called for the presentation on possible linkages and advance training. Godrej has major program on Salon development accordingly we are planning to associate with Godrej on CERTIFICATION part as they have

recognized certification for their diploma program. Details will be worked out after due consultation with CAIRN representative. Along with this Local unit of Gujarat livelihoods promotion council and Gujarat Handicraft departments have been involved for technical and potential financial support as and when emerged.


students as well as explore additional knowledge regarding innovative presentation delivery methods which may ultimately lead to successful implementation of program.

Their attendance and zeal to learn something new which witness that they procure immense pleasure under this course/program. ❖ **MOBILISATION:**

CCSC facilitators did make blue print for the mobilisation part. It included need assessment discussion part for the targeted community, pamphlets distribution among the targeted community people, home visits with a view to searching school drop outs and counselling process, advertisement into the newspapers. Indeed, appointed field enumerators along with facilitators who played significant role with the mean of interview schedule and simple random sampling procedure into some of the targeted rural and urban community viz.

1. Dhrol Local Community
2. Dhrolnerby villages in Rajkot and Jamnagar districts



Moreover, CSC mobilised the participants from above targeted areas with a view to furnishing quality education and escalating their inner potentialities as well as recommending income generating source or place with the principle of equality and religion, and without gender discrimination. In addition to, CCSC also gave equal opportunity to the girls and widow women who had strong will to study ahead but unable on account of some circumstances.

❖ **ENROLMENT:**


Enrolment is one of the significant parts which play vital role. After completing the procedure of mobilisation. The centre puts emphasis on the part of effective counselling part before putting them into the in house training.



❖ **TRAINING:**

Once students enrolled into the centre, facilitators play key role behind facilitating the appropriate training with the mean of orientation session, furnishing knowledge of basic English and computer literacy, conducting energiser sessions and recreational sessions as well as extra curriculum activities viz. Posters making, reflection of career timeline, essays writing etc. Apart from this, facilitators made students to generate their Gmail accounts at initial stage as well as

resume making at end stage in order to enable E-learning system.



91 Trainees have completed their training out of which 31 were Employability program trainees and remaining were from Tailoring and Beauty parlour.



JOB PLACEMENT and Self EMPLOYMENT:

CCSC has strategic arrangement with various job placement agencies in and around Jamnagar and Rajkot district and is making hard to place the trainees in jobs and self-employment. We are expecting nearly 65 to 70 % job placement or self-employment after this

training. The data will be shared once the process of job placement is completed with various agencies. We also have tied up with Labour Net for advance training if required for effective and sustained placement with major economic returns.



OUTCOME

Both centers accomplished three batches with the mean of sincere efforts, training and comprehensive guidance and forth batch is going on at both the center. At initial stage, some hurdles were faced into the part of students' participation. Later on facilitators of both CSC built strategies and appropriate plan and executed them into the manner through which enrollment, training and placements were taken care off quite effectively



Moreover, CSC mobilised the participants from above targeted areas with a view to furnishing quality education and escalating their inner potentialities as well as recommending income generating source or place with the principle of equality and religion, and without gender discrimination. In addition to, CCSC also gave equal opportunity to the

girls and widow women who had strong will to study ahead but unable on account of some circumstances.

❖ **ENROLMENT:**

Enrolment is one of the significant parts which play vital role. After completing the procedure of mobilisation. The centre puts emphasis on the part of effective counselling part before putting them into the in house training. In total 21 students enrolled for the employability program.

❖ **TRAINING:**

Once students enrolled into the centre, facilitators play key role behind facilitating the appropriate training with the mean of orientation session, furnishing knowledge of basic English and computer literacy, conducting energiser sessions and recreational sessions as well as extra curriculum activities viz. Posters making, reflection of career timeline, essays writing etc. Apart from this, facilitators made students to generate their Gmail accounts at initial stage as well as resume making at end stage in order to enable E-learning system. Out of 21 students 18 took the training with full attendance and completed the course.



Altogether 61 Trainees have completed their training at Skill Centre during the period of February and March 2018, out of which 18 were Employability program trainees and remaining were from Tailoring and Beauty parlour.

JOB PLACEMENT and Self EMPLOYMENT:

CCSC has strategic arrangement with various job placement agencies in and around Jamnagar and Rajkot district and is making hard to place the trainees in jobs and self-employment. We are expecting nearly 65 to 70 % job placement or self-employment after this training. The data will be shared once the process of job placement is completed with various agencies. We also have tied up with Labour Net for advance training if required for effective and sustained placement with major economic returns.

ઝીબ્રા કોર્સીંગ (Zebra Crossing)



રાહદારીઓને રોડ પાર કરવા માટે તેઓની સલામતીને ધ્યાનમાં રાખીને રોડ ઉપર ઝીબ્રા માર્કિંગ કરવામાં આવે છે. રાહદારીઓએ માત્ર ઝીબ્રા કોર્સીંગ પરથી જ રોડ પાર કરવાનો હોય છે. વાહનચાલકોએ ઝીબ્રા કોર્સીંગથી પહેલા પોતાનું વાહન ઊભું રાખીને રાહદારીઓને પહેલા સડક પાર કરવા દેવા બોલે અને તમામ રાહદારીઓએ સલામત રીતે સડક પાર કરી દીધેલ છે તેમ ચકાસીને પછી જ પોતાનું વાહન આગળ વધારવું બોલે. રાહદારીઓએ પણ પોતાની સલામતી માટે અને માર્ગ અકસ્માતમાંથી બચવા માટે હંમેશા ઝીબ્રા કોર્સીંગ પરથી જ સડક પાર કરવી બોલે. ચાર રસ્તા પાસે પણ ઝીબ્રા કોર્સીંગનું માર્કિંગ કરેલ હોય છે. તે ઉપરાંત ઝીબ્રા કોર્સીંગ પહેલાં STOP-LINE (સફેદ રંગની આડી સળંગ રેખા) દોરેલી હોય છે. તેનો અર્થ એ થાય કે વાહનચાલકોએ ચાર રસ્તા પાસે અથવા તો બંધ પણ STOP-LINE હોય ત્યાં STOP-LINEથી પહેલાં પોતાનું વાહન રોકી લેવું બોલે. સડક પાર કરતી વખતે ચક્ષુમાતમાં અને સડક પર પણ બંને દિશામાં બેતાં બેતાં ઝડપથી આગળ વધવાનું હોય છે. ઘણીવાર ઝીબ્રા કોર્સીંગ પાસે સડક પાર કરવા માટે સિગ્નલ મુકેલું હોય છે, જેમાં લીલા રંગની લાઈટ થયા બાદ જ રોડ ક્રોસ કરવો.







Women's Day also known as United Nations (UN) Day for Women's Rights and International Peace. International Women's Day celebrates women's achievements worldwide and throughout history.



Programme Sustainability

As long as micro intervention with regards to education is concerned, the sustainability point of view is taken care of with the available legal framework of PRIs and SSA. Health related micro interventions will be done in organized manner on Health and Nutrition day and will surely be sustained as it would be observed by department of Health in every health centre/sub-center or AWW centre. Livelihoods enhancement activities will be the pillar for obtaining and sustaining improved lifestyle. Sustainability in the project context involves a continuous interaction of three elements, each representing a key aspect of project interventions. These include:

Institutions -The project has initiated various processes for strengthening the capacity of School Management Committees and Panchayats, which will enhance the communities' capacities to analyze issues of education and demand for services. This will also ensure community participation in all educational activities bring ownership of the process bringing accountability in service delivery.

Delivery mechanism -The project is closely working with the district administration for enhancing the capacities of frontline staff making them more committed and accountable. On the other hand it will influence the implementation mechanism of services by demonstrating models for replication.

Enabling policy framework -The Government of India has been proactive in bringing about suitable legislations to achieve the MDGs in education by implementing Right to Education Act, Child Labour Act and also special provisions to promote girl child education. The initiatives of devolving powers in education sector to the PanchayatRaj Institutions is also another opportunity to bring about accountability and transparency in implementation of education programs. The Village Education Committee, mandatory as part of the SarvaSikshaAbhiyan will facilitate in bringing the education issue to the forefront at the Gram Panchayat level.

The strategy of working with the mainstream agencies and involving communities as active stakeholders has been proven to be effective in many programs. The multiplier effect can also transcend not only sector boundaries, but also geographical boundaries if the lessons learnt and models are widely exposed among multiple stakeholders.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW


The MLI:

MLI Title:

Vocational Tailoring Training with Marketing Linkage Interaction and Motivation workshops

Specific objective:

To provide with an alternate employment opportunity for the rural girls by training them in to tailoring

Village: DHROL-Jamnagar:**Period:** February-March 2018

Implementation Strategy:

Total of 24girls with age group from 18 to 35 were identified for training out of which 23 were selected for the training on the basis of their willingness to attend the training regularly for the effective and quality training. Training was divided in two batches, each of 12 trainees. Training was done daily between 9 to5.30 with theory and practical coaching by well trained and proven trainer from Dhrol itself.

Process: After discussions and interaction with girls, their parents and local panchayat members and authorities in village and block place it was decided to initiate tailoring training at Dhrolof Jamnagar district considering the high demand from girls from nearby villages. A Full time trainer along with assistant was hired with arrangement of six stitching machines. Trainee registration was done voluntarily by local leaders as well at the training center and list of 34 girls was prepared and submitted to CEDRA coordinator. After detailed consultation with CAIRN representative a meeting of registered girls was called. During the meeting it was decided that since the participation was more there will be 2 batches of 12 each during the day between 9 to 5.30. At the end of the assessment 23 participants joined and completed two months training of Tailoring.



The inaugural and closing ceremonies were done in the presence of local leaders along with CAIRN official Mr. Avinash Raval(Closing) and Mr. Pradeep (Inaugural). Ms. Suhag patel from Women Association USA, Ms. Anju Xavier, PM CEDRA and Mr. Sanjay Vincent, Director CEDRA and other officials also remained present as per the schedule. Local authorities and people appreciated Cairn efforts& also taken responsibility to make this training effective & successful

with their possible cooperation. Training and its quality were appreciated by all the trainees and their parents. At the end of the training all the participants were awarded with the certificate towards the acknowledgement of completion of the training.



Outcome:

- This training is appreciated and it has strengthened the capacity and employability of rural girls, especially from minority community, as they are capable of stitching variety of dresses, makes them more employable and skilled.
- Every participants have decided to start their jobs or self-employment with small scale from their home only if resources are limited.
- Provides scope for replication. It's a model for replication.

Quality Control:

- CAIRN officials and CEDRA official have closely monitored the activities by frequently visiting the training site for better quality and motivation.

Motivational Support:



CAIRN officials always visited the training center and motivated the trainees for better outcomes. Mr. Sumit from audit department also visited the skill center along with Mr. Avinash Rawal and appreciated the stitching work of participants and delivered motivational speech.

Forward Linkages:

- A guest from USA Ms. Suhag Patel, President, South Asian Community Outreach visited the center and assured the trainees of forward support in terms of marketing in USA if the stitching is with quality. CEDRA has assured her to make sure about the quality outputs of stitching by trainees.
