

Introduction:

The year 2020-2021itself is a year of challenges. OVID has been the biggest challenge for everyone. The world is facing slow down and economic crisis due to lockdown and other measures taken by te authorities to overcome and protect the communities from the pandemic. CEDRA being a nongovernmental organization had to shut down its operation for some months and convert some of its projects in to digital mode so that community enjoy its benefits in the critical conditions. Some urgent relief operations were carried out and the Sk8ill Development program was converted into Digital mode and needy youth were given Employability training through on-line sessions on android platforms.

In this transformation we had to train our staff to combat the new age challenges under New Normal arrangements. All the staffs were given one week long training on digital platform to continue the Skill development program with On-Line mode. Minimum physical activites were done with proper care and under strict guidelines of Covid 19.

We had some scope to do offline activities in couple of months during the pandemic when the effect was lesser and government did the unlocks in series to restore the normal life style with due alertness over covid conditions and strict following of guidelines. Some schools surveys and other awareness and developmental activities were carried out in this period to provide the benefits to the community.

CEDRA Background:

Established in 1995 under the Trust Act and also registered under FCRA, CEDRA (Centre for Education Developmental Research and Action) is a modest attempt to reach out to the poor, downtrodden and oppressed citizens to envisage an equitable and balanced society. CENTRE FOR EDUCATION DEVELOPMENTAL RESEARCH AND ACTION (CEDRA) conducts necessary research to know the need of the community then organize various programs on education, health and livelihoods as an action followed by the surveys and research. CEDRA has implemented various projects for international organizations like HelpAge India, CAIRN India, Save the Children, Gujarat Quick Relief Coordination Committee (GQRCC), Holland and Indo-German Social Service Society, Germany along with Conducting Socio Economic Impact assessment, Impact evaluation, C M &E, Socio-Economic Survey, Training and Capacity building programme on Micro Entrepreneurship Development (MED), SHGs, Cluster development, Gender, Health etc for government organizations like GWEDC, ICDS, GGRC, GEC , departments like Forest, Agriculture and international agencies like World Bank/IFAD, NORAD and SAP India.

In last three years CEDRA has implemented projects for partners like Balmer Lawrie, CARIN INDIA, IIM Ahmedabad, Help Age India and Quest Alliance along with some individual donors for some charitable activities.

Education, Health, Livelihoods and Infrastructures are some of the areas where CEDRA has implemented various programs like Slum Education and Rural Education initiatives, Free Health Camps, Skill Development and employability training for youth and Women, Installation of Community based RO plants and constructed 12 Room School are some of the interventions to be quoted. Other than these CEDRA also have earned good name in Social Data collections and Research by conducting various studies with institutes like IIM Ahmedabad and Gujarat Green Revolution Company limited.

1. EDUCATION:

CEDRA carried out various interventions for inspiring the student towards improved learning outcomes, like distribution of School bags to promote Enrolment in schools, Distribution of Inspirational books, Distribution of Prizes and Gifts to students taking parts in various competitions in sports and culture and also by celebrating various days in schools alongside subject specific training in partnership with CAIRN India.

CEDRA also carried out in-depth Research Program in partnership with IIM Ahmedabad to know the education qualities promote improved learning outcomes in Primary education sector. CEDRA carried out Assessment of School Management Committees for IIM Ahmedabad and UNICEF towards identifying the role and responsibilities of the SMCs.

CEDRA also did knowledge partnership with **quest alliance** to promote **STEM education** in schools where CEDRA is working, unfortunately schools were closed due to covid conditions and project could not be taken up.

2. LIVELIHOOD: SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Quest Alliance Program:

CEDRA in partnership with Quest alliance implements the project of SKILL BUILDING to increase the employability among the educated youth of urban Gujarat. CEDRA aims to train and employ more than 350 youth under the program. It's a dream of Government to make the youth more employable along with their routine education by imparting specially designed Computer and English language skill training.

ABOUT CEDRA SKILL CENTRES

CEDRA with its 2.5 decades of experience and good insight over Skill Building focused on quality along with the targeted quantity. The batches at the centers in Ahmedabad(Himmatlal Park, Nava vadaj (vyaswadi), ,Shivshakti Nagar, & New Nikol,)and in Anand (Anand Dist) Nadiad (Kheda Dist), Dhrol (Jamnagar Dist) Palanpur (Kabirchowk) started as per the schedule and 2100+trainees got effective employability training with exposure to various guest faculties from retail, engineering and services.

Under the tagline of enabling self learning approach among the students under the program of "Skilled to Succeed" a Quest Alliance supported project, CEDRA skill centres (CSC) play pivotal role with the mean of furnishing valuable insights about skilled to succeed program and enable self learning approach among the students as well as explore additional knowledge regarding innovative presentation delivery methods which may ultimately lead to successful implementation of program.

Moreover, these centres had/have created healthy environment and flexible schedule at centres and among the students which may assist to give appropriate attendance, share their ideas, views and queries in front of the facilitators as well as among the classmates. Their attendance and zeal to learn something new which were/are witnessed that they

obtained/obtain immense pleasure under this course/program. In addition to, the efforts of making them to self aware for career building as well as to choose appropriate career not first job which generates fire of confidence among the students. The facilitators of CSC who were/are effectively groomed under the QUEST team which may assist to facilitate into the class. The facilitators of CSC also share their ideas, views and queries into the centralise meeting of CEDRA. This is the way facilitators and management team mutually coordinate with each other in order to achieve common goal.

METHODOLOGY

Generally the facilitators of the CSC who put emphasis on below mentioned four key parts:

- 1. Mobilisation
- 2. Enrolment
- 3. Training
- 4. Job placement

✤ MOBILISATION:

Into the first batch of both CSC of Ahmedabad cities, facilitators did make blue print for the mobilisation part. It included need assessment discussion part for the targeted community, pamphlets distribution among the targeted community people, home visits with a view to searching school drop outs and counselling process, advertisement into the newspapers.

Moreover, CSC mobilised the participants from above targeted areas with a view to furnishing quality education and escalating their inner potentialities as well as recommending income generating source or place with the principle of equality and religion, and without gender discrimination. In addition to, CSC also gave equal opportunity to the girls and widow women who had strong will to study ahead but unable on account of some circumstances.

✤ ENROLMENT:

Enrolment is one of the significant parts which play vital role. After completing the procedure of mobilisation, CSC scrutinised the eligible students as per the check list and then enrolled. These centres put emphasis on the part of effective counselling part before putting them into the in house training.

TRAINING:

Once students enrolled into the centre, facilitators play key role behind facilitating the appropriate training with the mean of orientation session, furnishing knowledge of basic English and computer literacy, conducting energiser sessions and recreational sessions as well as extra curriculum activities viz. Posters making, reflection of career timeline, essays writing etc. Apart from this, facilitators made students to generate their Gmail accounts at initial stage and Linked In accounts as well as resume making at end stage, their User ID and passwords in order to enable e-learning system. At last, students put their sincere efforts behind market scan and mock interview parts.

✤ JOB PLACEMENT:

We have just completed the training batch and now focussing on employment of the trainees. CSC makes their efforts with various job placement consultancies for better jobplacements viz. for better job opportunities, Team lease Consultancy, Innovsourse Pvt Ltd,Quess Corp Limited, Brand Factory,Star Bazaar, D-mart, nu Future Digital (India) Limited,Kotak, Mass call Net, Digital, 3Desire Networks & Solutions India Pvt. Ltd. Amazon.

OUTCOME

Facilitators of CSC built strategies and appropriate plan and executed them into proper manner. It was challenging task to mobilize, enroll, and train the students into the first batch. Moreover, students of all CSC felt and admitted that how they were and how they improve at end of the batches. The students' inner zeal and readiness behind attending the class with physical and psychological presence of mind as well as participating into each and every conducted extra curriculum activity which helped to enhance life and work skills among them. They generated fire of confidence and idea of choosing appropriate career. They created self-awareness regarding their inner potentialities as well as current challenge and opportunities into the market. Additional knowledge includes understanding of decision making power, money and time management, interview facing part - these all are significant knowledge led them on appropriate path.

Online training:

As mentioned earlier, majority of our skill development training was carried out in ONLINE mode with digital platform over Google Meets or Zoom. Some interesting sessions were conducted on Facebook live too to engage more alumni.



UMEED: Youth Employability Program

UMEED was introduced and implemented by SAATH in association with Gujarat Urban Development Mission GUDM) for increasing employability of urban youth towards urban poverty alleviation. This program was implemented through NGOs and CEDRA is one of the partner agency for the same having UMEED program in Palanpur in association with Pananpur Municipality and SAATH for Banaskantha District.

Alumni connect:

Though UMMED was not implemented we have taken it in our annual report because our alumni are still with us and they become part of our various programs. Whether its a research project or relief project in the areas. They are place but still render their services if required on temporary basis.

The project with Quest also runs for the last 5+ years and almost all the alumni are in our touch and available for some temporary assignment or awareness campaigns etc. May it be research data collection; data Entry, Workshop on gender, plantation or Relief work, old trainees are available if they are working in surrounding areas.

CEDRA provided training to 285 students under UMEED in Palanpur and made placement of 238.



3. EDUCATION & LIVELIHOODS:

Micro level Intervention (MLI) in partnership with CAIRN India

Introduction:

CEDRA in partnership with Cairn India is implementing the Micro level Intervention (MLI) in Cairn pipe line villages under CSR in Gujarat. The main focus and strategy of MLIs are to cater the communities' needs on the basis of their demands identified by themselves. The priority sectors are Education, Environment and Health along with some selective infrastructure interventions. Accordingly, various intervention were done by CEDRA as suggested, advised and directed by CARIN India district representatives under the guidelines of CAIRN India CSR management.

Micro Level Interventions (MLI)

CEDRA has undertaken various activities under MLI as per the suggestions from CAIRN India representatives. Activities include Education level intervention, Women Empowerment, Health and Nutrition, Sanitation, Environmental Awareness etc.

Activity Detail:



VEDANTA Limited- Cairn Oil & Gas and CEDRA has organized a COVID-19 awareness program at Navchetan Vidhyalaya Junagam on 25th Frbruary 2021 to increasing awareness about COVID-19 and understanding about the importance of proper use of Mask and Hand Sanitizer as an easy, effective and affordable way to prevent virus and save lives.

The program was started with pray singing by school students and inaugurated by a school teacher Mr. Yogeshbhai Patel. School Principal Mr. Satishbhai Patel delivered a lecture on a need for the awareness program. Street Play: A short play was performed in a rural style explaining the importance of OZONE, risks over it, reasons behind it, way out to save the layer of Ozone and how to protect overall environment. The play was beautifully presented and students enjoyed it with interaction and supporting the quotes. The actor then offered pledge to protect the Ozone by minimizing the use of equipments responsible for generating carbon which creates risk for Ozone layer.

Drawing Competition: Interclass drawing competition was organized between the students of class 9-12. Altogether 25 students participated, out of which 10 were girls and 15 were boys. First and second prizes were given to both the categories. They portrayed their feeling and understanding about Ozone layer on the basis of awareness generated through street play.

4. INFRASTRUCTURE:

On infrastructure we have supported district, block and village level administrations in developing facilities in the benefit of general public i.e. contribution towards Community Village Water Tank construction and School water tank repair.



Supporting health and other infrastructure in villages:

5. HEALTH AND HYGIENE

Background:

Health and Hygiene are interconnected and the importance of Hygiene is on priorities in India following the Clean India campaign launched by our Prime Minister. CAIRN India being a responsible and proactive corporate always believes in supporting the system towards holistic development. Just to accelerate the efforts of government towards making India a beautiful and Hygienic place which promotes general health and develop health seeking behaviour among the citizens, as a partner of CAIRN India we decided to launch a workshop cum Campaign in selected villages of Jamngar after due discussion with Cairn representative and local administration under the Micro Level Intervention (MLI).

These MLIs were divided in two parts; 1. Health and Hygiene Workshops, that targeted school Children and 2. Health and Hygiene Campaign: targeting village community as a whole. Village sarpanch, BRC, CRC, School principals and other local officials remained present to encourage school children to participate in various competition organised on this event. 6. RELIEF AND REHAB:

Relief work during heavy floods:

This time Gujarat has suffered a lot due to heavy rainfall resulted in flood and loss of property and nearly 70 human lives along with thousands of death of animals in the districts of Banaskantha and Patan.

CAIRN INDIA in association with implementing partner CEDRA has carried out relief work in both the districts by delivering and distributing packaged edibles like Namkins, Biscuits and mineral water along with polythene bags.

The details are as under;

7. RESEARCH:



CEDRA from its inception believe in strong research and action on the basis of the findings. Whenever CEDRA has scope to be part social research its always has a big impact on results with its strong and committed teams available to carry out all types of social research.



CEDRA carried out 5 research projects with IIM Ahmedabad out of which four researches were targeting the better and improved learning outcomes in the government primary schools. These projects were done in association with UNICE on behalf of IIM Ahmedabad.

CEDRA also carried out validation studies for IIM Ahmedabd to validate ODF status of various district in Gujarat.



During the year CEDRA also took up studies with PWC to map the impact of mining on local people in and around Vadodara District.



Way Forward:

• HELPLINE Initiative:

Centre for Education Developmental Research and Action (CEDRA), popularly known as CEDRA is registered under Bombay Public Charitable Trust Act alongside having registration with Income Tax department (12 A and 80 G) and Ministry of External Affairs (FCRA). It has 27 years of experience in implementing range of projects in sectors like Education, Public Health, Livelihoods, Infrastructure and Social Research.

Relief and Rehabilitation is one of the major interventions of CEDRA as it has constructed a 12 rooms school as the school in village bhrugupur was destroyed during massive earthquake in Gujarat in 2001 and supported 36+ community relief camps during critical riots in 2002. On the same ground CEDRA is running a relief program for Covid affected people which include distribution of Ration Kits, Masks, sanitizers, Oximeters and services of Oxygen concentrators. CEDRA would like to continue such intervention in coming years too.

AASAAN Help Line is one of the relief and rehab initiatives of CEDRA as mental health has become the biggest challenge for today's society which is deteriorated during the covid pandemic for the last two years. People need psychological support and counselling to overcome their mental health disturbances. They want somebody to listen to them so; we have launched such help line which caters in Hindi and English.

We are looking for expansion and would like to run more such Help Lines alongside continuing the current one. We expect Support in both the areas:

Approximately a help line with day -night services will require about 8 lakhs per year. This will have highly professional counselors who can speak English-Gujarati and English together.

• SKILL DEVELOPMENT Initiative on DIGITAL MODE:

CEDRA being an experienced organization in carrying out Skill Development program for years alongside having implemented fully digital training program of Youth during the pandemic is keen to implement such programs on vast scale to cater maximum youth under Skill development initiative which also offers placements.

• STEM Project Initiative: :

CEDRA is preparing to implement STEM project in association with various potential partners in the schools of Gujarat considering the need of today's education infrastructure and CEDRA's exposure with academic sector of Gujarat in association with Indian Institute of Management and UNICEF towards improving the education in Gujarat.
