## **The Event:**

### **SUPPORT TO SAPDA GRAM PANCHAYAT UNDER PPP RS.51973**

#### **Specific objective:**

To help the local body and community in accessing the basic facilities of drinking water by supporting the community and Gram Panchayat in paying the community share of 10% towards fulfilling the high cost water supply project



The state Government under its water supply department tries to provide mega structures in solving the long lasting problems of drinking water in villages under its Water and sanitation Management Organization. Under this they give major grants to the local bodies up to 90% and remaining 10% is collected from the local communities and Panchayats. Considering the village economies and financial conditions of local panchayat the demanded 10% becomes difficult and in this scenario people of village loose the mega projects which could have easily addressed their most connecting community problem.

Considering the impact and connectivity of the problem we analyse the issue of helping the people by supporting the Panchayat in mobilizing the 10% under our CSR intervention. We found it effective and more result oriented, impacting and benefitting the whole village so we started supporting the panchayats on receiving the request letters from the SARPANCH and distributed the CHEQUE in presence of the villagers and leaders along with School Principal and SARPANCH.
