Letter to Staff Regarding Covid-19 Case at Winsport.

March 20th 2020

Hey everyone,

This letter is to update you regarding a confirmed case of Covid-19 at one of the venues we work. The venue I am referring to is **WinSport** (previously known as Canada Olympic Park or COP).

I do believe that all staff that worked events there recently are in the clear, but in the interest of safety for our True North team members I want to lay out the facts. I know this kind of news can be troubling, but with awareness of the facts, should come reassurance. After getting the facts, here is what I know, and how it may affect us.

- A player in the WinSport Hockey Canada League (WHCL) has tested positive for the Covid-19 virus.
- The player's most recent game played in the hockey arenas building was on March 6th. At the time he did not have any symptoms, but none the less can still be a carrier.

Due to the fact that there is a 14-day period where you can carry without seeing symptoms, if the individual had played other games in the league prior to this March 6th date, then there is a possibility that True North staff would have been onsite during this period. The two (2) events at WinSport during this period are the following.

- **Canadian Synchronized Skating Championships.** (Skate Canada)
- **Pace Kids Gala** (in the Canadian Sports Hall of Fame)

Due to the low risk of spread, **AHS has not recommended that self isolation is necessary** (including for the player's teammates and the refs), however I did want to make you aware of the incident, in the name of safety.

Since then, Winsport has halted all public operations. The dressing rooms and arena area have undergone a deep clean and sanitization. The arena has been deemed safe, but in the interest of public safety and following public health officials' guidelines regarding public gatherings, the facility will remain closed for ice rentals for the time being.

The chance of transference to staff members in attendance at these events is extremely low, but nonetheless, all staff members (in attendance at these events, and otherwise) should be monitoring their own health in these trying times. If you show any symptoms, please follow public health guidelines and self isolate.
