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

TREE FARM PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 37 ½" × 56 ½"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric. Pattern designed by J. Wecker Frisch of Great Joy Studio.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric

RST = Right Sides Together

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

All fabrics from the Classic Christmas collection unless stated otherwise.

(1) PD16280-PANEL Christmas Botanical Main Panel

Additional Fabrics:

% yard CD16282-PARCHMENT Christmas Collage 1 % yards C16284-WHITE Christmas Sheet Music ½ yard C16285-RED Plaid (binding)

OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies 1 ⅓ yards WB660-RED Swiss Dot (wide back backing) Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Christmas Botanical Main Panel

Fussy cut (1) 23 %" × 42 %" Panel rectangle, centered over the motif.*

*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.



Parchment Christmas Collage

Cut (4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as A.

(2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $27 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Label as B.



White Christmas Sheet Music

Cut (2) 5 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as C.

Cut (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × LOF* strips. Subcut:

(2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as D.

*Note: The D-rectangles are cut LOF so the fabric is facing upright in the side borders.



Red Plaid

Cut (5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Set aside for binding.

SEWING TECHNIQUES


Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

TREE FARM PANEL QUILT

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **A**-strip to each side of the Panel rectangle as shown below. Next, sew (1) **B**-strip to the top and bottom. In the same manner, sew **D**-rectangles to the sides and **C**-rectangles to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

2. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Red Plaid binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
