GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together

SNF = Stitch and Flip

2 yards WB660-RED Swiss Dot (wide back backing)
Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Santa's Tree Farm Panel

Fussy cut (4) 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Panel squares, centered over the motifs.*

*Note: If the panel motifs do not reach the edge of the required cuts, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size.



Pebble Confetti Cotton™

Cut (5) 2 %" × 2 %" squares. Label as A.



Forest Woodland

Cut (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as B. Cut (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as C. Cut (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as D.

Cut (1) 2 ½" × 4 ½" rectangle. Label as F.



Green Woodland

Cut (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as B. Cut (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as C. Cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as D. Cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as E.

Cut (1) 2 %" × 4 %" rectangle. Label as F.



Forest Berries & Boughs

Cut (1) 2 %" × 12 %" rectangle. Label as B.

Cut (1) 2 %" $\times 8 \%$ " rectangle. Label as D.

Cut (1) 2 %" × 6 %" rectangle. Label as E.

Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as F.



Green Plaid

Cut (1) 2 %" × 12 %" rectangle. Label as B.

Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as C.

Cut (1) 2 ½" × 6 ½" rectangle. Label as E.

Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Label as F.



Sky Snowflakes

Cut (8) 2 1/4" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(8) $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " × 18" rectangles. Label as G.

(8) 2 %" × 14 %" rectangles. Label as H.



Snowy Snowflakes

Cut (7) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(10) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as I.

(10) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Label as J.

(10) 2 ½" × 3 ½" rectangles. Label as K.

(60) 2 %" × 2 %" squares. Label as L.

Cut (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strip. Subcut:

(10) 1 %" × 2 %" rectangles. Label as M.



Green Berries & Boughs

Cut (9) 3 ¼" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(10) $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " × 18" rectangles. Label as N.

(10) 3 %" \times 12 %" rectangles. Label as O.



Forest Main

Cut (6) 5" × WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) $5" \times 64"$ strips. Label as P.

(2) $5" \times 55"$ strips. Label as Q.

Cut (2) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(1) 2 %" × 12 %" rectangle. Label as B.

(1) 2 ½" × 10 ½" rectangle. Label as C.

(1) 2 ½" × 8 ½" rectangle. Label as D.

(1) 2 ½" × 6 ½" rectangle. Label as E.

(1) 2 %" $\times 4 \%$ " rectangle. Label as F.



Rudolph Snowflakes

Cut (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Set aside for binding. Cut (6) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × WOF strips. Piece together end-toend; subcut:

(2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 55" strips. Label as R.

(2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 53" strips. Label as S.

SEWING TECHNIOUES

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.





BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Use the SNF method to make the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.








Arrange (2) J-rectangles, the required SNF units,
 (2) K-rectangles, (2) L-squares, (2) M-rectangles,
 (2) I-rectangles, and (1) A-square as shown below. Sew the pieces and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Tree Unit. Repeat to make
 (5) total Tree Units, matching the SNF units together as shown in the diagrams below.





Sew (1) O-rectangle to each side of (1) Tree Unit. Next, add
 N-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Tree Block.
 Repeat to make (5) total blocks.



4. Sew (1) **H**-rectangle to each side of (1) Panel square. Next, add (1) **G**-rectangle to the top and bottom to make (1) Panel Block. Repeat to make (4) total blocks.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Arrange (5) Tree Blocks and (4) Panel Blocks as shown below. Sew the blocks together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.

6. Sew (1) S-strip each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) R-strip to the top and bottom. Sew (1) Q-strip to each side of the quilt center. Next, add (1) P-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

7. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Rudolph Snowflakes binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
